The Rocky Branch Trail offers beautiful views of the Raleigh city skyline, while also passing through the length of the North Carolina



The Rocky Branch Trail offers beautiful views of the Raleigh city skyline, while also passing through the length of the North Carolina State University campus. It also links to Pullen Park, which has an aquatics center, arts center, amusements and community center, as well as softball fields and tennis courts.

At its northwest end, the trail connects with the Reedy Creek Trail. At its southeast end, the Rocky Branch Trail connects with the [Walnut Creek Trail](#), which heads east and west through Raleigh.

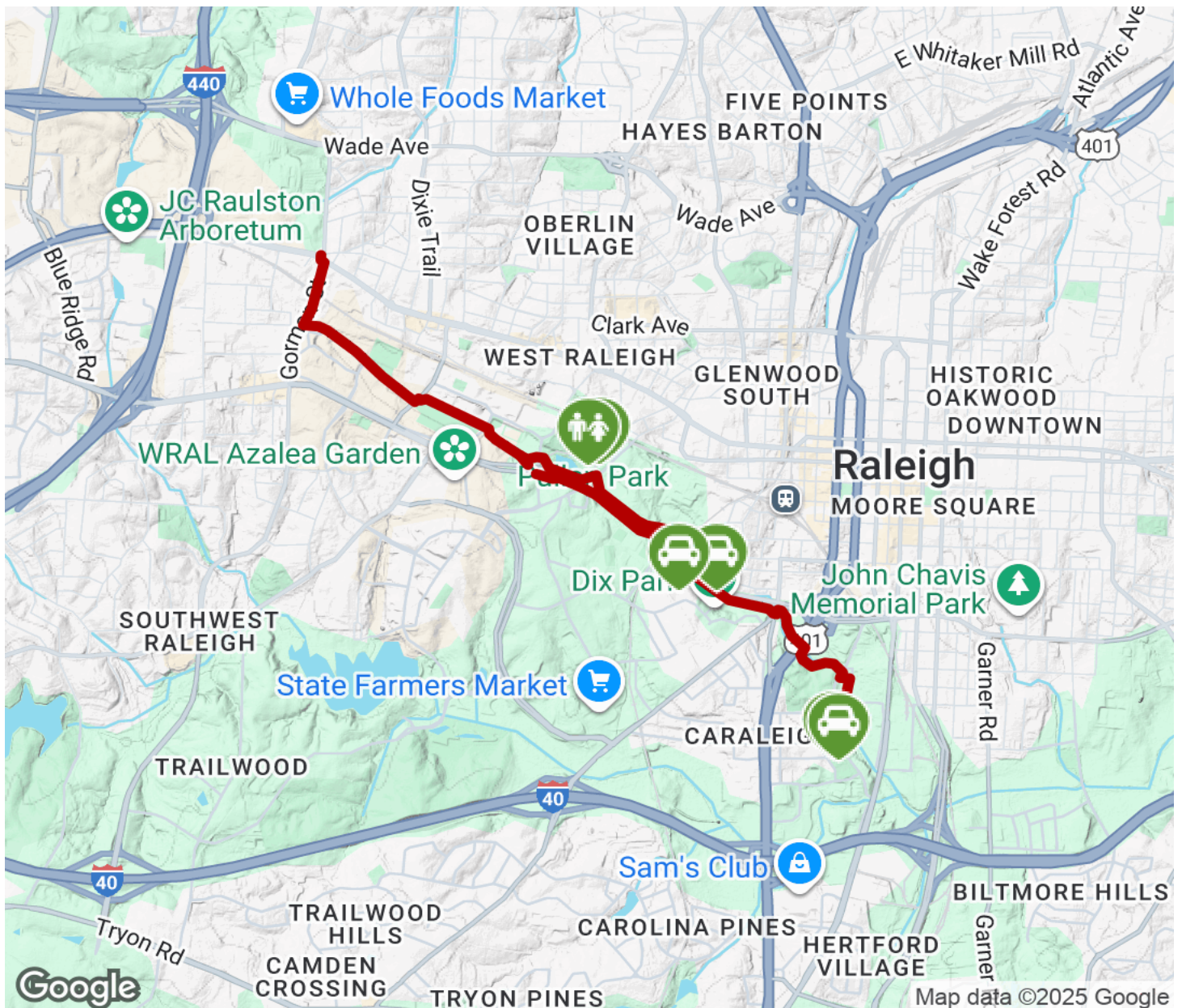
Parking & Trail Access
