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For much of its short length, the Lions Park Greenway travels along Sloan Lake, offering pleasant views of the water. In warm weather, trail-goers can enjoy boating and fishing on the lake, or relaxing on the beach. The trail begins in one of Cheyenne's most popular parks: Lions Park, which provides playgrounds, picnic shelters, athletic fields and a pool.

With a connection to the [Yellowstone Road Greenway](#) at its northern end, travelers can also easily access other areas of the city.

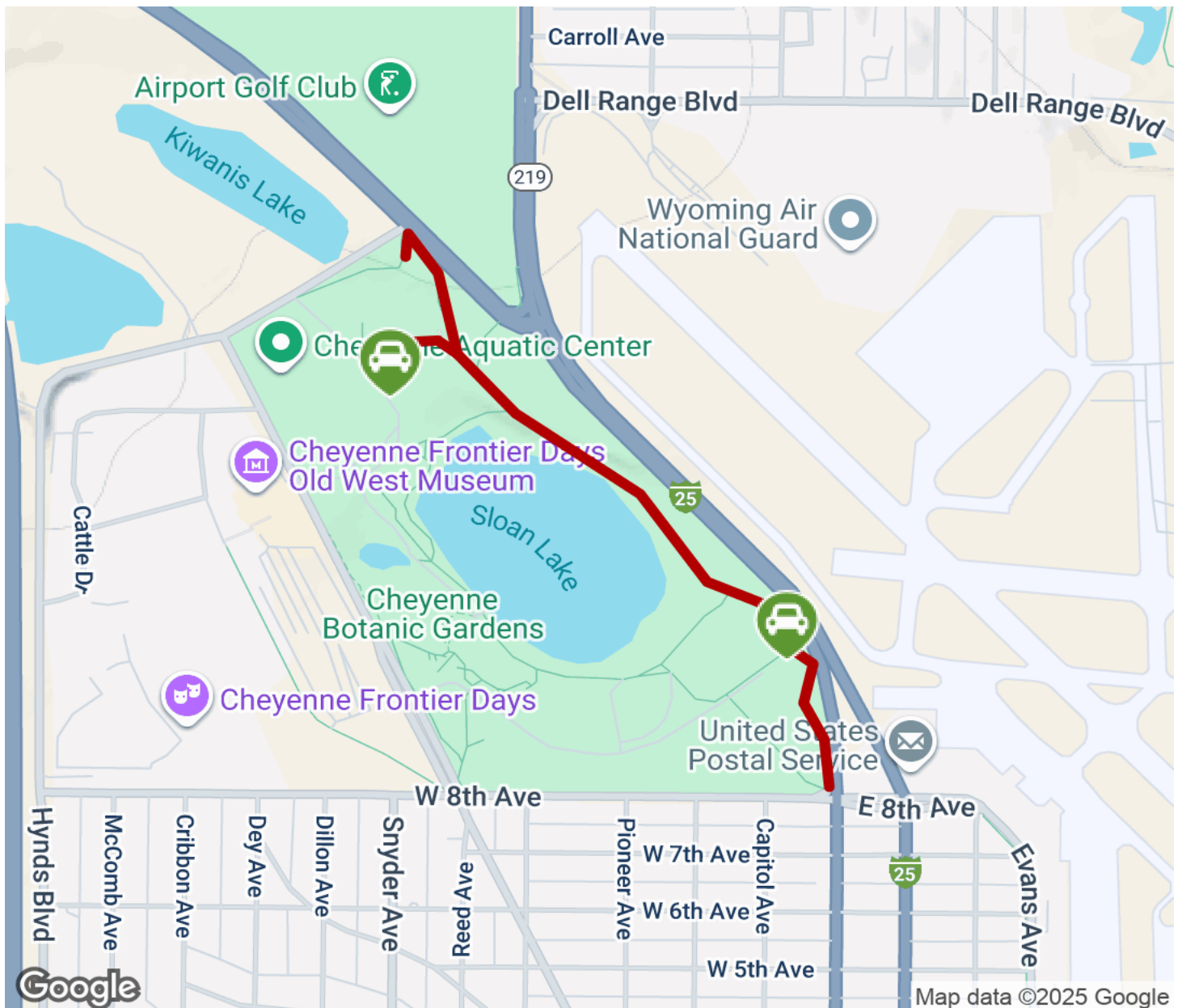
Parking & Trail Access
