The East Cheyenne Greenway provides a pleasant route through residential areas of eastern Cheyenne. The eastern half follows N.



The East Cheyenne Greenway provides a pleasant route through residential areas of eastern Cheyenne. The eastern half follows N. College Drive for much of its length and ends with an expansive view of the Sun Valley Open Space. The second half extends the trail west from N.College Drive to Holliday Park. This part of the trail travels mostly through industrial Cheyenne, and also provides access to the athletic fields of VFW Pride Park.

At Holliday Park, one of 25 behemoth steam engines is displayed and preserved. 'Big Boy' steam engines were the biggest in the world when they were built for Union Pacific in the 40's. Cheyenne's own Big Boy was retired in 1958 and relocated to the park in 1963.

Parking & Trail Access


Parking is available at United Nations Park (E. 10th Street and Monroe Avenue) near the southern end of the trail. Take the sidewalk west along E. 10th Street for 3 blocks. The street will end at Baldwin Drive; turn left (south) on Baldwin and travel 2 more blocks to E. 8th Street. Take a right (turn west) on E. 8th Street and travel a short distance to the trail.

You can also find parking, as well as restrooms, tennis and basketball courts at Holliday Park. The parking lot can be accessed via E. 16th Street.
