Meandering down a Bonneville Power Administration overhead electric utility corridor, the 3.8-mile BPA Trail serves as a connector between Celebration Park and the downtown areas of Federal Way with its southwestern neighborhoods.

About the Route

The trail runs behind offices in the city, providing an opportunity for non-motorized commuting.

There are also frequent access points to neighborhoods, highlighting the trail's usefulness as a commuting corridor for outlying neighborhoods.

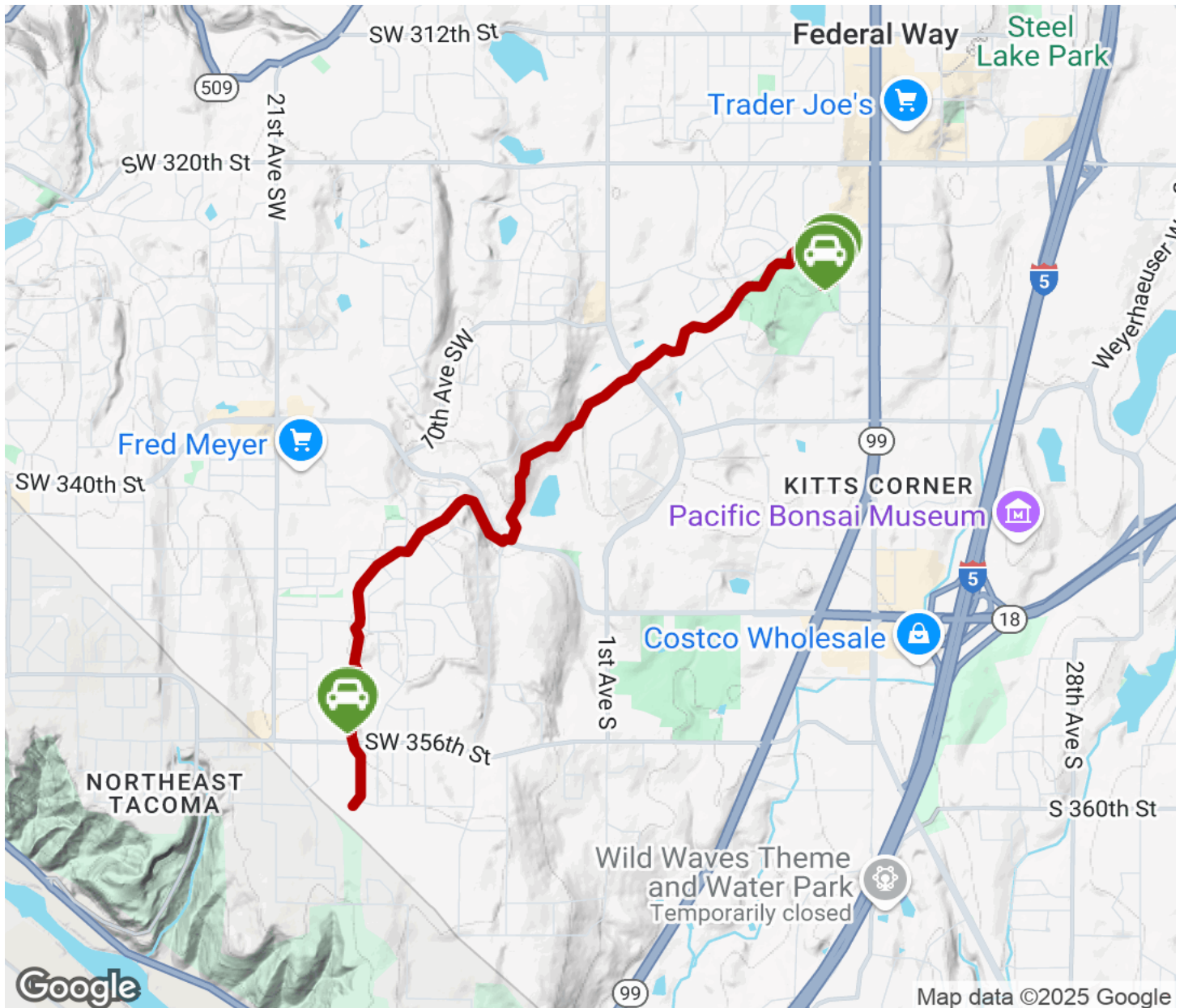
