Near the BPA Trail's midpoint, the [West Campus Trail](#) branches off as a 1-mile spur, providing access to more of Federal Way's residences and medical offices.

Meandering down a Bonneville Power Administration overhead electric utility corridor, the 3.8-mile BPA Trail serves as a connector between Celebration Park and the downtown areas of Federal Way with its southwestern neighborhoods.

### About the Route

The trail runs behind offices in the city, providing an opportunity for non-motorized commuting.

There are also frequent access points to neighborhoods, highlighting the trail's usefulness as a commuting corridor for outlying neighborhoods.

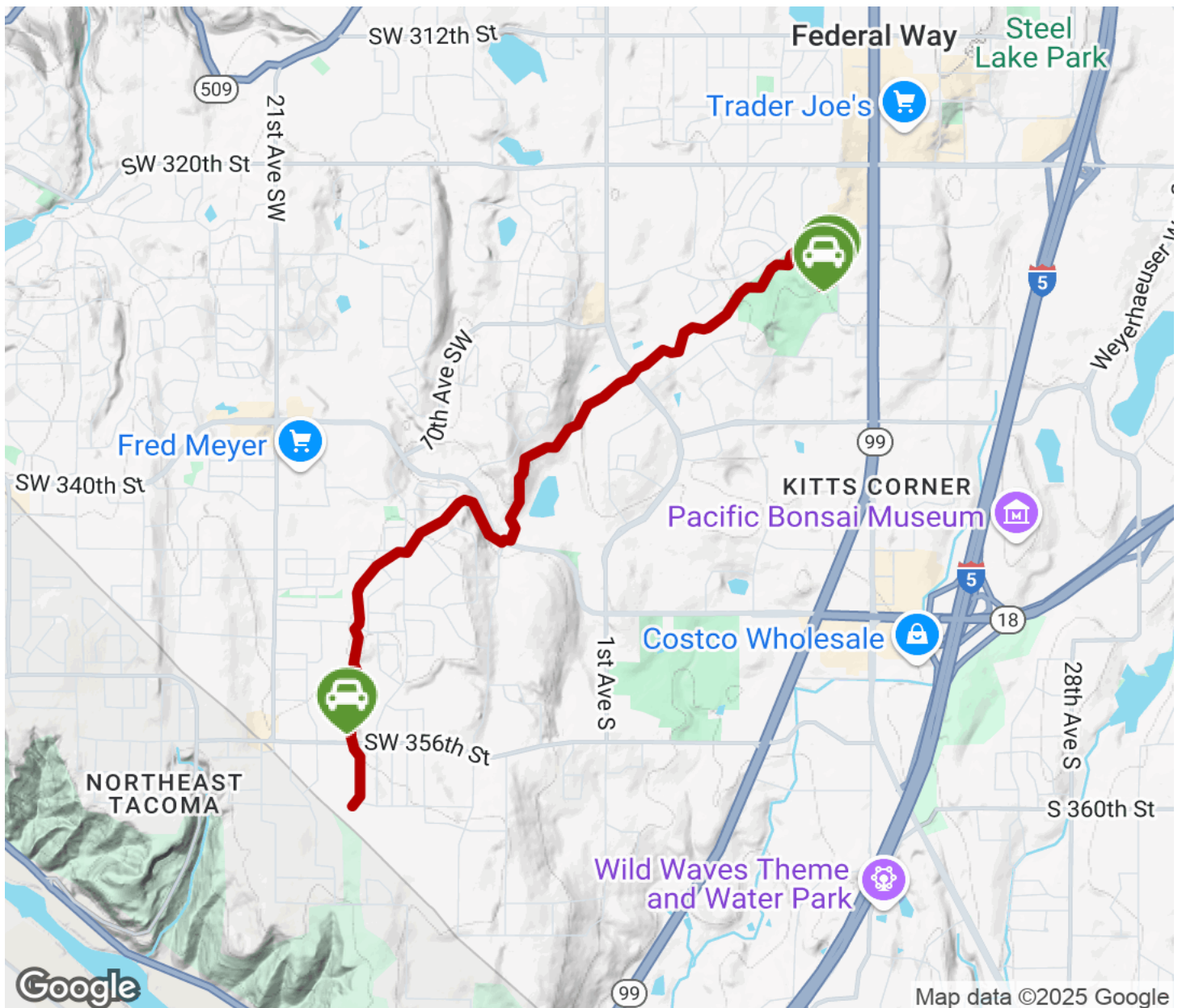
