Brush Creek Trail (CA)

California

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Like many trails in Santa Rosa, the Brush Creek Trail follow the path of a local waterway. Beginning at its convergence with the larger Santa Rosa Creek, the Bush Creek Trail meanders northward. With its western side paved and its eastern side packed dirt, this trail provides the choice of riding/walking surface. A spur provides convenient access to Rinconada Park.

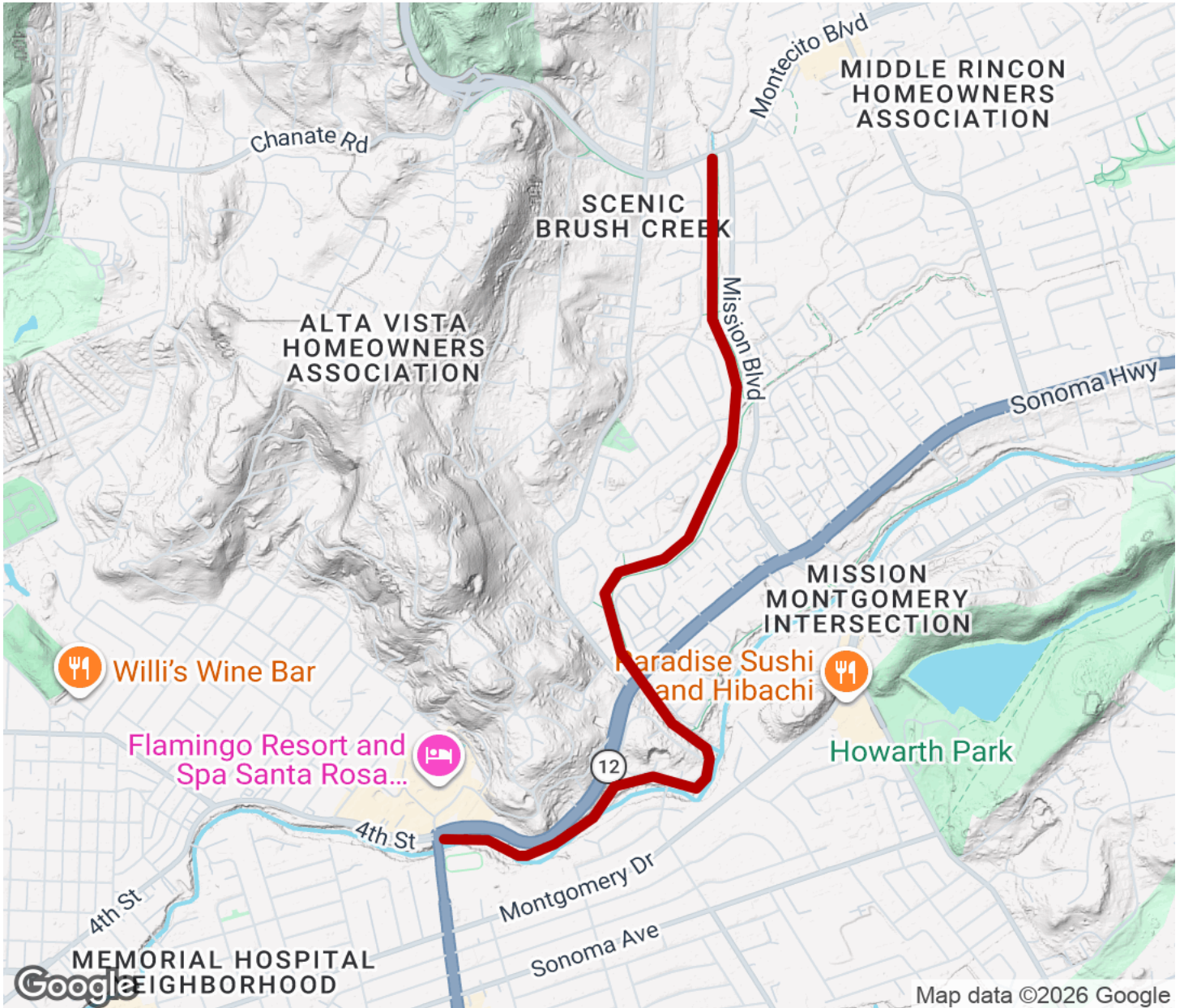
Parking & Trail Access
