As its name suggests, the path primarily serves neighborhoods adjacent to Isabel Avenue. 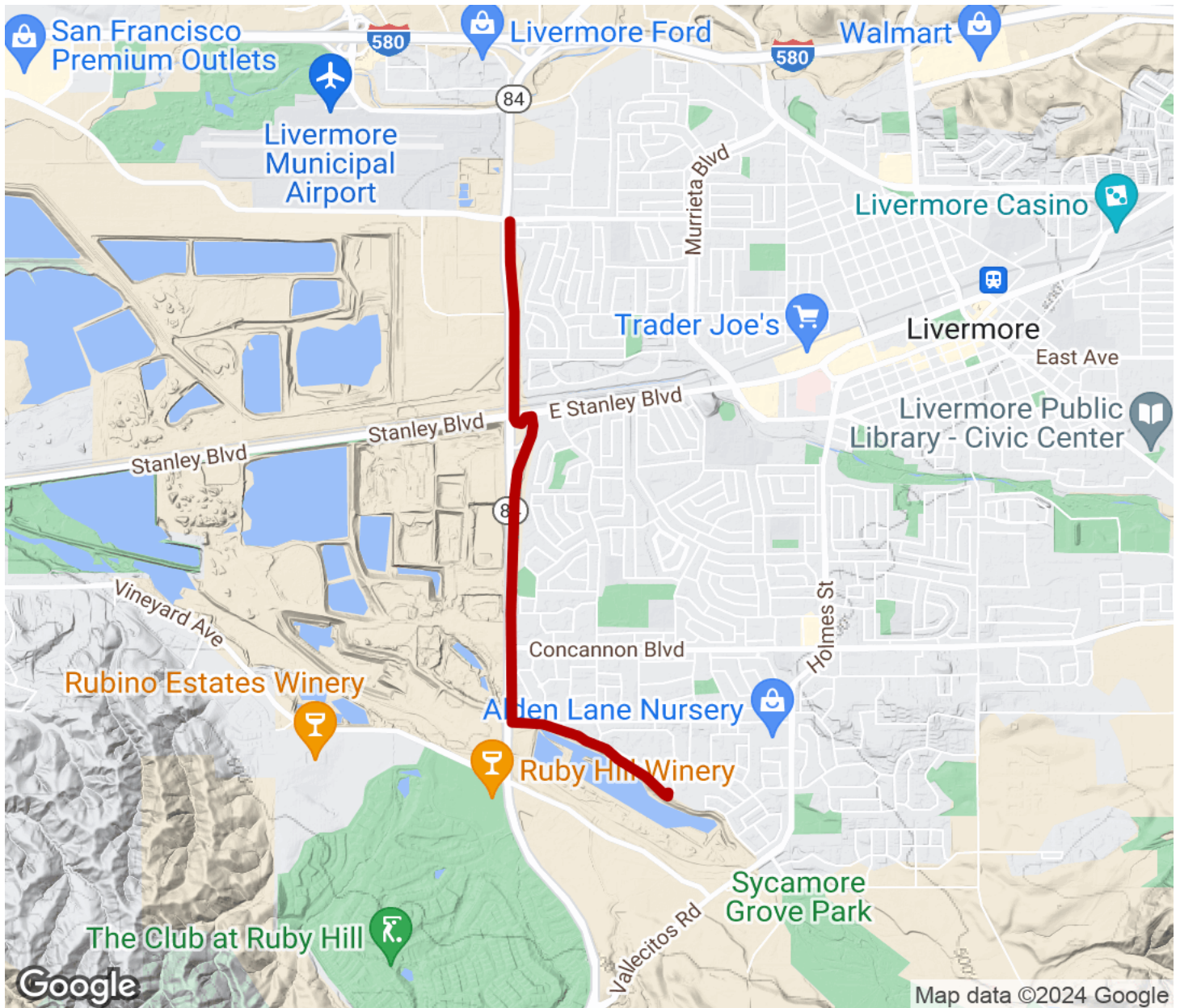
Parking & Trail Access
