The Isabel Avenue Trail runs north-south on the western boundary of Livermore in the eastern San Francisco Bay area's Tri-Valley

As its name suggests, the path primarily serves neighborhoods adjacent to Isabel Avenue. The trail also connects to the [Arroyo Mocho Trail](#), which offers additional biking and walking options throughout Livermore.
