## Isabel Avenue Trail California



The Isabel Avenue Trail runs north-south on the western boundary of Livermore in the eastern San Francisco Bay area's Tri-Valley



The Isabel Avenue Trail runs north-south on the western boundary of Livermore in the eastern San Francisco Bay area's Tri-Valley region. As its name suggests, the path primarily serves neighborhoods adjacent to Isabel Avenue. The trail also connects to the <a href="Arroyo Mocho Trail">Arroyo Mocho Trail</a>, which offers additional biking and walking options throughout Livermore.
