

Riverwoods Trail -Missouri River Greenway *Missouri*



Although a relatively short route, the Riverwoods Trail offers plentiful scenic views of the Missouri River and historic St. Charles.



Although a relatively short route, the Riverwoods Trail offers plentiful scenic views of the Missouri River and historic St. Charles. The trail closely follows the river's shoreline through wetland forest. Begin your journey at the northern trailhead off St. Charles Rock Road in Bridgeton, where you'll find restrooms, picnic tables and parking.

The Riverwoods Trail forms a paved loop with the <u>Earth</u> <u>City Levee Trail.</u> Trail users can connect from the Earth City Levee Trail to the famed <u>Katy Trail</u> via a protected bike path on the SR 370 bridge.

A half-mile section of the trail along the Missouri River is permanently closed due to multiple flooding events. You can still walk, bike or run on the rest of the greenway and



enjoy sweeping views of the river and historic St. Charles on the west side of the river.


Parking & Trail Access
