McLeod Creek Trail Utah



The McLeod Creek Trail begins north of downtown Park City near the Snow Creek Medical Center. It merges with the Olympic



The McLeod Creek Trail begins north of downtown Park City near the Snow Creek Medical Center. It merges with the Olympic Parkway Trail along McLeod Creek for about a mile to Meadows Drive before paralleling State Route 224 to the Farm Trailhead. The wide, flat pathway takes trail-goers through wooded areas, over bridges with scenic views and past unique sculptures before becoming open country at Old Ranch Road.

Parking & Trail Access

From Interstate 80, take exit 145 onto SR 224 to Park City. After four miles, the Farm Trailhead will be on the left. Parking is also available at Willow Creek Park, located at the intersection of Old Ranch Road and Split Rail Lane, and the Park City Trailhead located off SR 224, across from the large white barn of McPolin Farm, a famous city landmark.
