Forest Creek Trail

North Carolina



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The Forest Creek Trail is an important connector between the [Longleaf Trail](#) at its southern tip and [Nick's Creek Trail](#) at its northern end. The adjoining [Forest Creek Access](#) also links it to Reservoir Park, which features a 95-acre lake popular for boating and fishing. In addition, the trail is useful for students attending the abutting Sandhills Community College and O'Neal School.

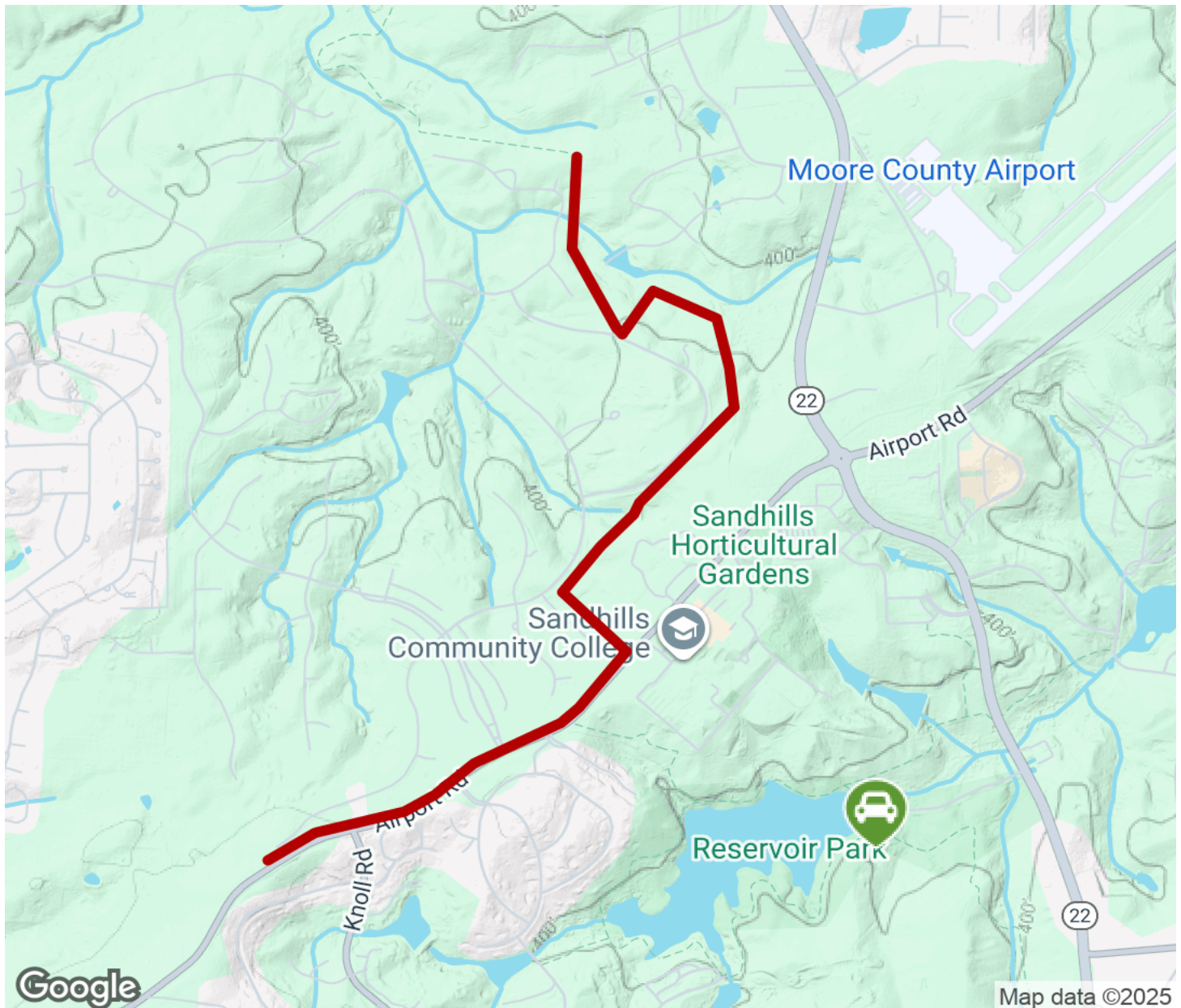
Parking & Trail Access
