Big Cove Creek Greenway

The Big Cove Creek Greenway travels nearly 3 miles through eastern Huntsville, connecting the Hampton Cove and Cove Creek



the McMullen Cove community.

The Big Cove Creek Greenway travels nearly 3 miles through eastern Huntsville, connecting the Hampton Cove and Cove Creek communities with the natural habitats surrounding Big Cove Creek. Trail-goers will enjoy views of the creek, forests, swamps and fields. The trail also runs adjacent to the Hampton Cove Elementary School, making the outdoors accessible to young students.

The trail ends at the Hays Nature Preserve, a sprawling city park offering miles of trails through swamps and wooded areas. To extend your journey through the park, hop on the [Flint River Greenway](#).

Mid-trail, travelers can also pick up the [Little Cove Road Greenway](#) to go 5 miles northeast to the Flint River and

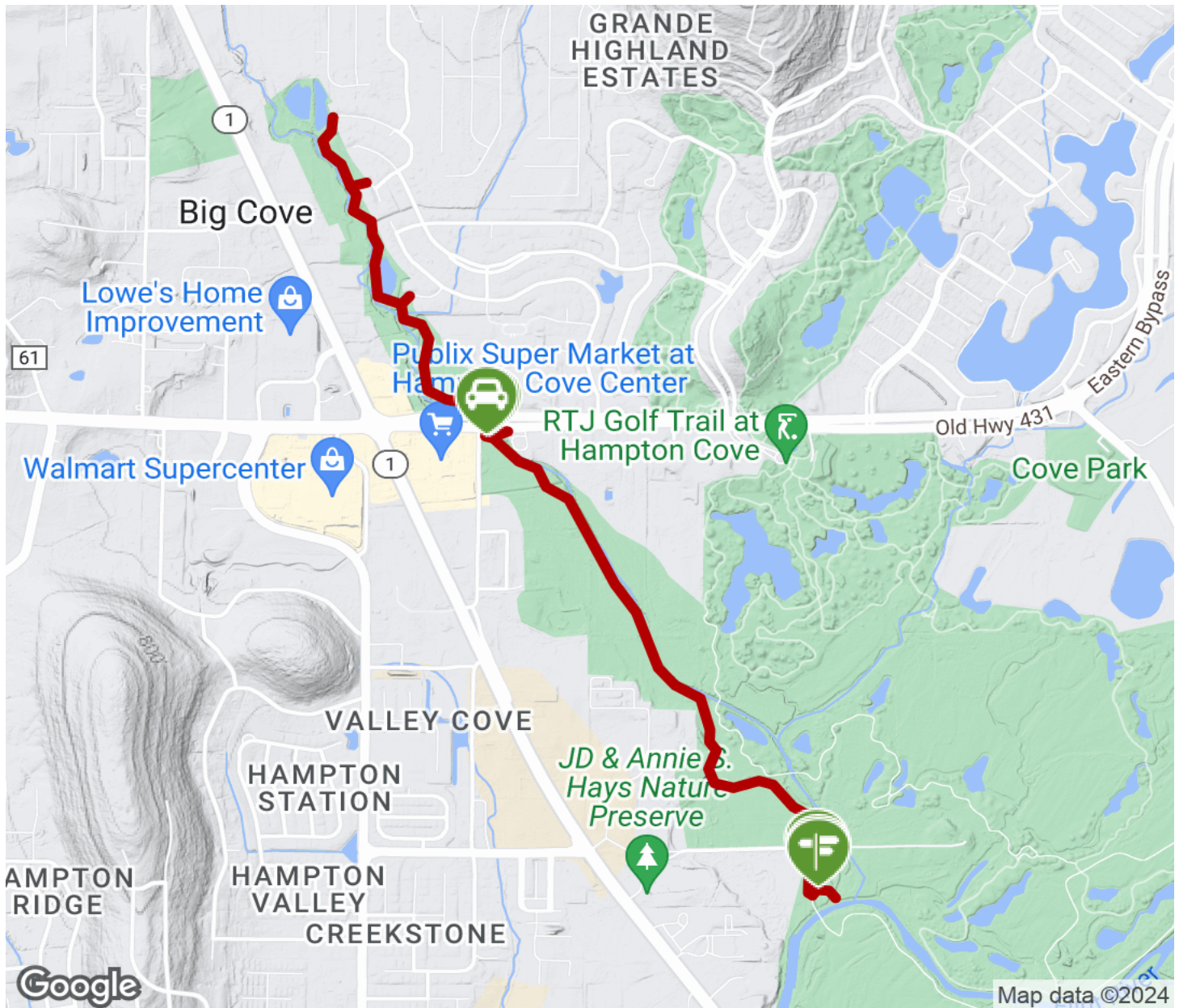
Parking & Trail Access
