At the southern end of the trail, paid parking is available off Bridge Street near the MBTA rail station.



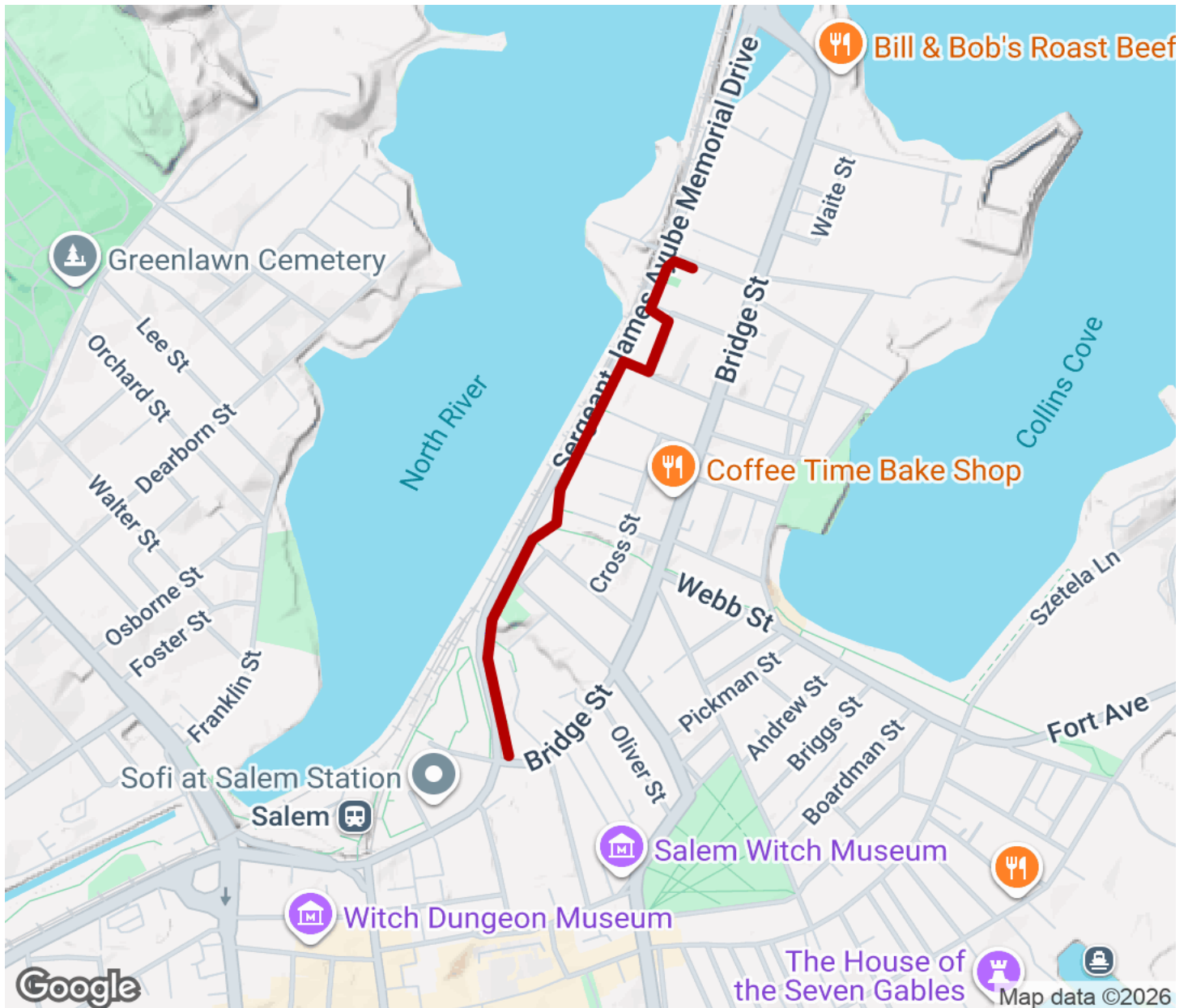
