The South Carthage Rail Trail runs between the Smith County Agricultural Center and downtown South Carthage along Old Highway 53. It follows the former Carthage Branch of the Tennessee Central Railroad, built in 1888, and offers scenic countryside views. The path is wide and paved with an easy grade.


