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The McAdams Bike Path, so named because it leads to the northern edge of McAdams Park, provides an important connection between two other popular trails: the [K-96 Bicycle Path](#) and the [Canal Hike and Bike Trail](#). 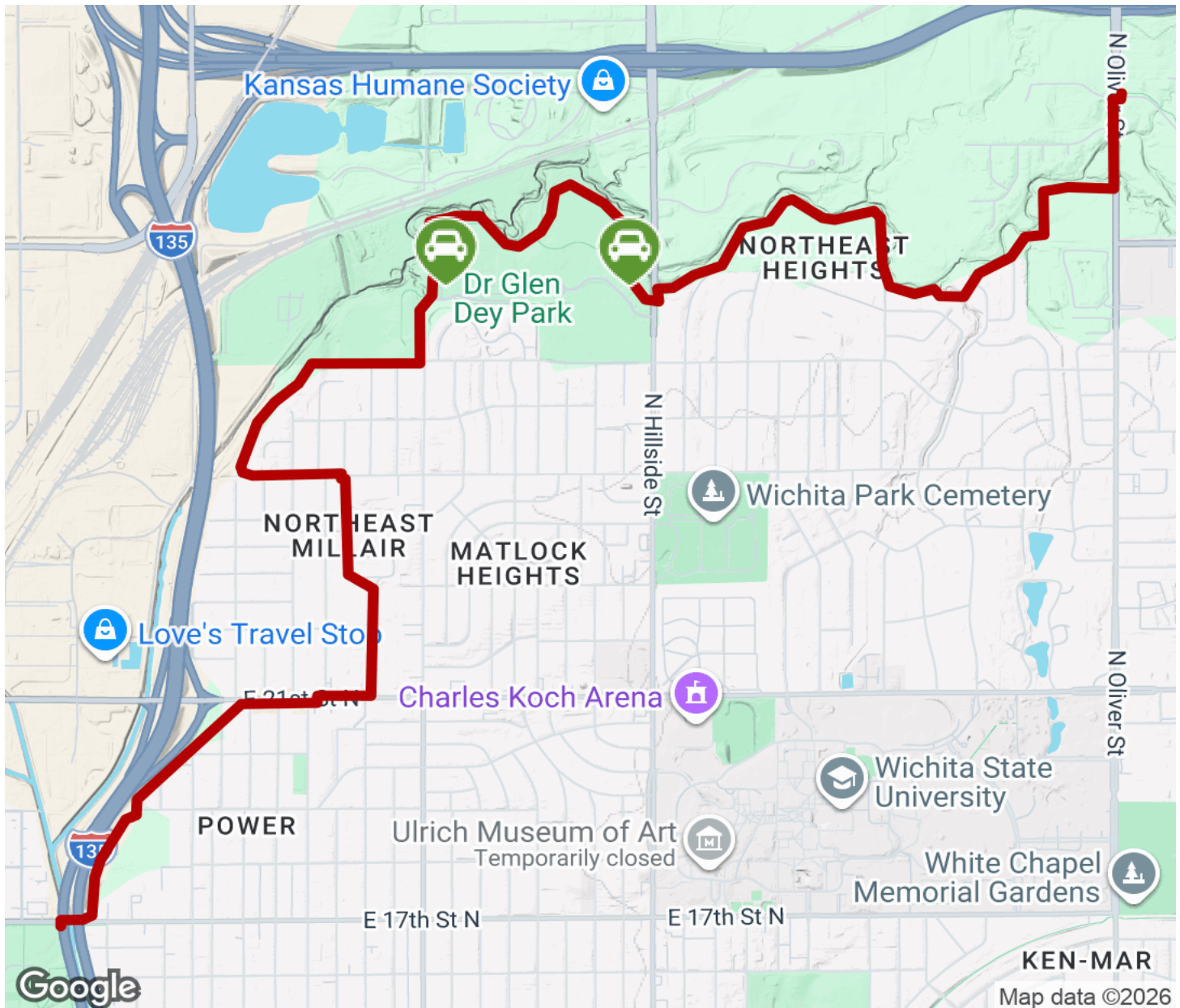
