The 5.9-mile Rock Creek Trail provides an important commuting route and natural escape in one of Oregon's largest cities:



The 5.9-mile Rock Creek Trail provides an important commuting route and natural escape in one of Oregon's largest cities: Hillsboro, located in the "Silicon Forest," a high-tech corridor on Portland's western side. The trail runs through a scenic greenway offering beautiful views of the creek, towering evergreens, meadows, and wetlands. Orchard Park is a good place to start the journey; the park offers parking, restrooms, and picnic areas. The trail then travels north across paved and boardwalk sections to the trail's end in Rock Creek Park.

Another disconnected section of trail heads west-east between NW Rock Creek Blvd and the [Westside Trail](#). This trail similarly cuts through a sliver of green space.

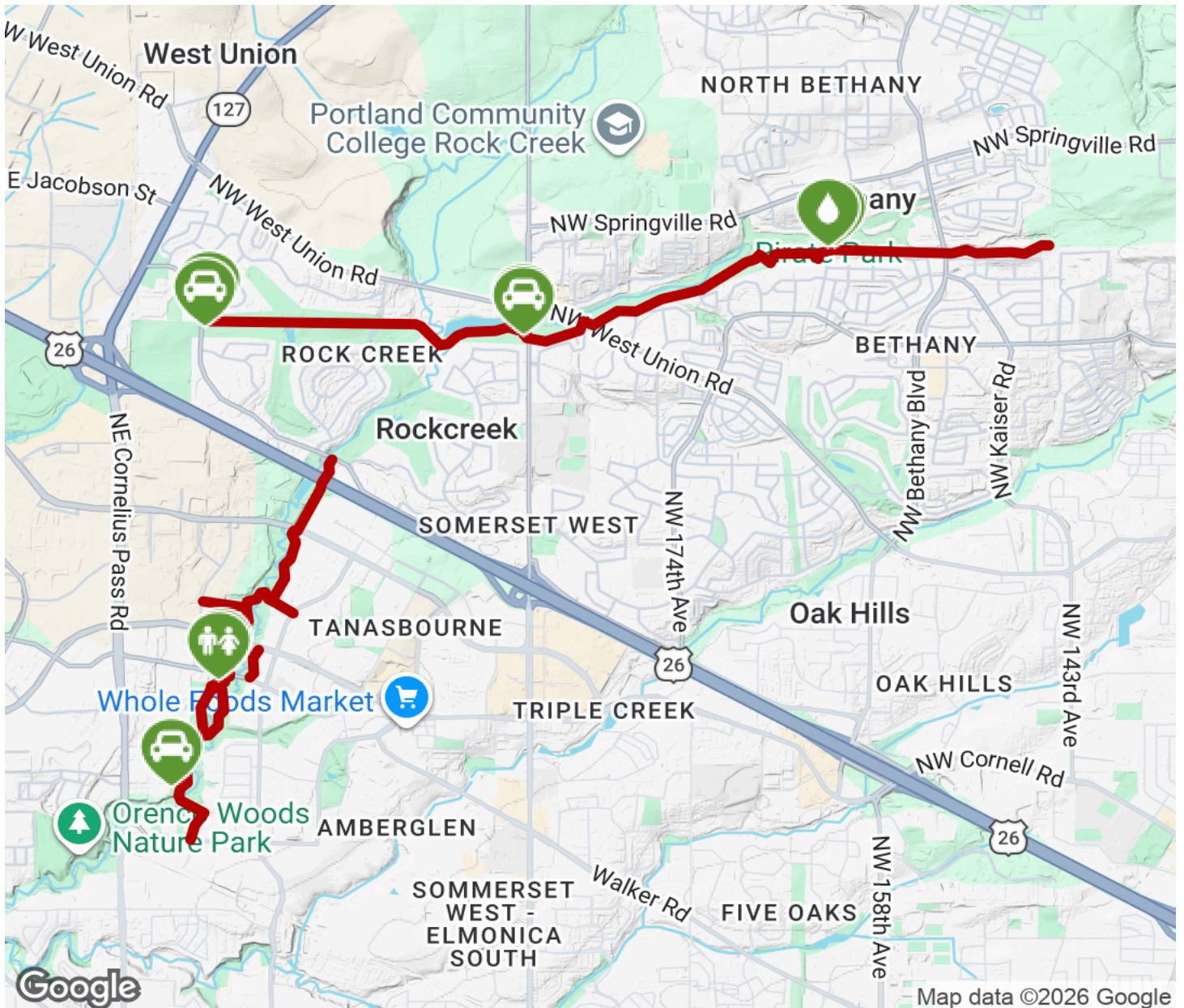
