Also known as County Bicycle Route 7, the 4.5-mile Black Creek Trail in southwestern Miami-Dade County runs between Black Point Park & Marina and Larry & Penny Thompson Park.

About the Route

The Black Creek Trail runs south from Miami through neighborhood parks, connecting trails and neighborhoods. At its southern end, trail users can look for manatees, alligators, and birds that call the Biscayne Bay home. The southern end of the trail switches from a paved trail to crushed stone.
