Blackfish Parkway Trail lies in the southwestern corner of Shawnee, a suburb of Kansas City. Although the trail follows a major roadway, much of the route is lined with mature trees and nice homes. Along the way, look for the Shawnee Indian Prayer Wheel, a sculpture by Charles Goslin.

From the trail's western end, you can connect to other trails: <u>Lackman Road Path</u>, <u>Midland Drive Path</u>, and <u>Little</u> Mill Creek Trail.
