Although only a mile long, the 79th Street Path connects important recreational amenities in Lenexa, a southwestern suburb of Kansas City. The paved, east-west route parallels its namesake roadway through a pleasant residential area.

On the path's western end, you can hop on the 2-mile <u>SMP Paved Trail</u> to travel through Shawnee Mission Park, where you'll find sheltered picnic spots, an archery range, a disc golf course, and many other amenities. The park is the largest in the county and also features a scenic 120-acre lake popular for fishing and boating.

The path's eastern end enters Lackman Park. Head north along Lackman Road and you'll soon reach <u>Lackman Road Path</u>, which connects to more parks, shopping areas, and
