## Rolling Ridge Trail

*Kansas*



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The Rolling Ridge Trail winds through the city of Olathe on the southwestern outskirts of Kansas City. At its northern end, the paved route provides access to Prairie Center Park, a 75-acre recreational amenity offering opportunities for soccer, baseball, basketball, disc golf and fishing. There are also picnic shelters, restrooms and a playground.

As the trail continues south through a wooded area, you'll travel past a Walmart Supercenter. Here, you can connect to the [W. Santa Fe Street Path](#) to reach destinations east or west.

At the north end of the Rolling Ridge Trail, visitors can park at Prairie Center Park (555 N. Olathe View Road).



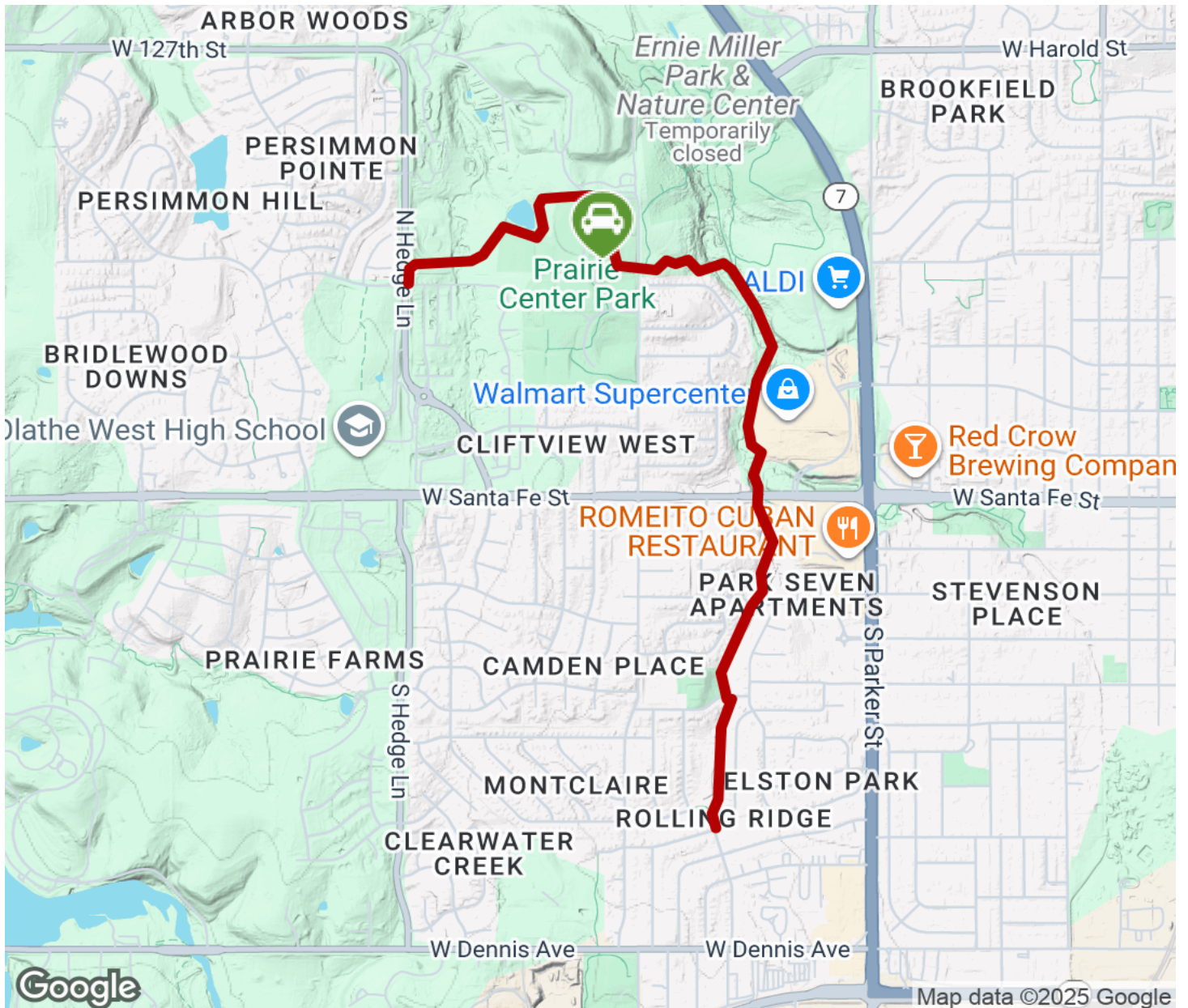
