The Monticello Road Path offers a paved north-south route through Shawnee on the western outskirts of Kansas City. It connects shopping areas, housing subdivisions and schools.

At the north end of the trail, you can turn east and follow the sidewalk along the south side of Johnson Drive for about a mile to reach the [Gary L. Haller National Recreation Trail](#). That trail runs for 17 miles through the linear Mill Creek Streamway Park and provides access to the popular Shawnee Mission Park.


Parking & Trail Access
