The Pepper Creek Trail, located in the western outskirts of Temple, is considered to be one of the city's most scenic and iconic



The Pepper Creek Trail, located in the western outskirts of Temple, is considered to be one of the city's most scenic and iconic pathways. It begins at State Highway 36 and travels south for just over a mile through a wooded area following the western bank of Pepper Creek. Highlights include unique water features and a pedestrian bridge.

At its southern end, it connects to the [FM 2305 Trail](#), a 4-mile east-west route. Mid-way, a spur takes trail-goers to the Scott & White Continuing Care Hospital, where parking is available.

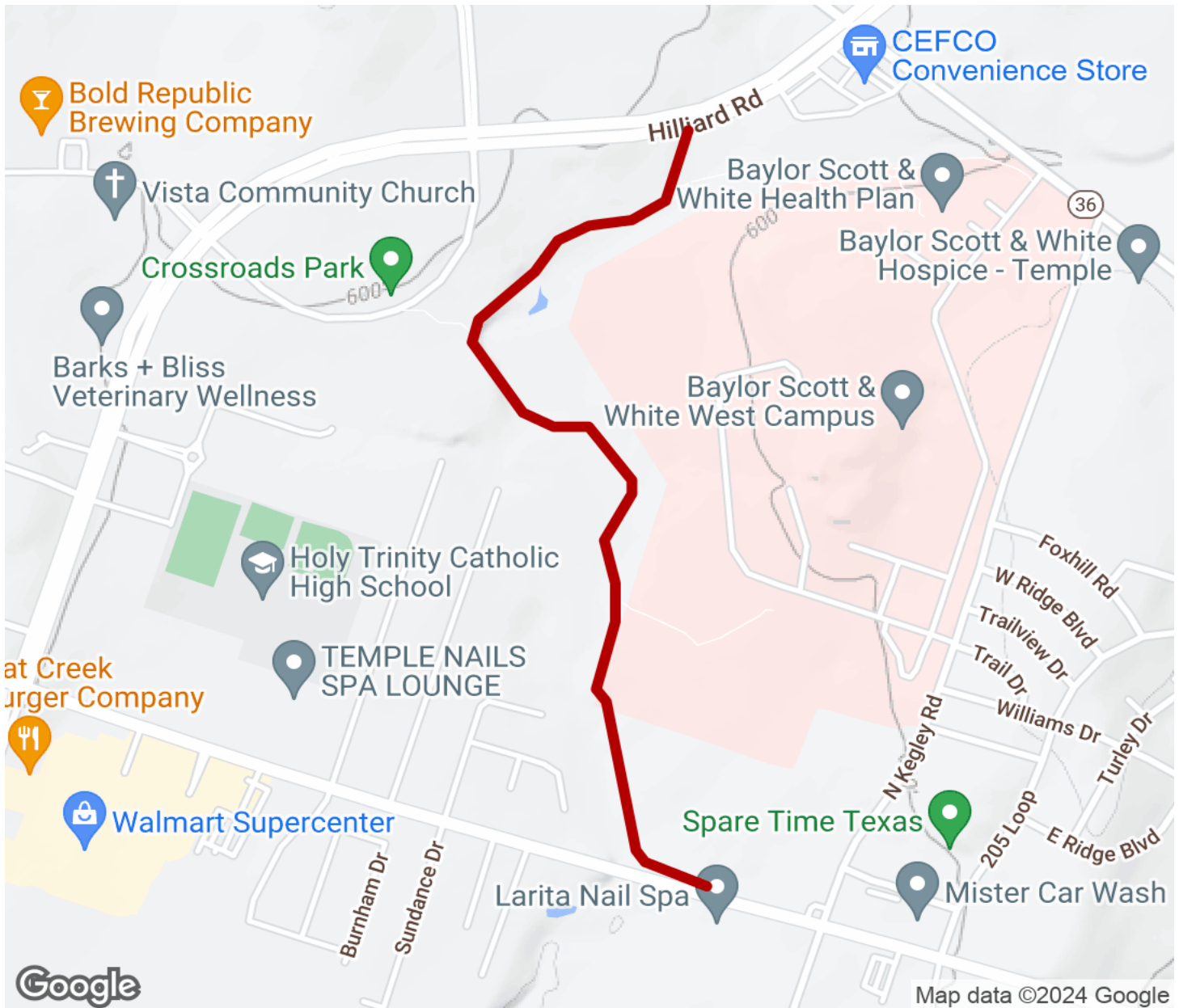
Parking & Trail Access
