About the Route

The southern end of the Pepper Creek Hike & Bike Trail meets with the FM 2305 Hike & Bike Trail and heads north. The entire path is paved concrete and runs alongside a small creek. The next portion of the path follows alongside Research Parkway before leaving the road and running through an open field. The northern of the trail is a dead end just north of McLane Parkway.


The Pepper Creek Hike & Bike Trail runs between the FM 2305 Hike & Bike Trail (Temple) and McLane Parkway (Temple).
