Chickies Rock Overlook Trail

Trail History

The trail follows an old trolley line route that once took tourists up to Chickies Rock in the early 1900s.

As its name implies, the half-mile out-and-back Chickies Rock Overlook Trail leads to a beautiful vista in Chickies Rock County Park.

About the Route

Start at the trailhead on its eastern end (off Chickies Hill Rd) and head west along the tree-lined pathway until the trail ends after a short distance at a cliff towering above the Susquehanna River. Enjoy the spectacular view of the river and, in the distance, rural landscapes and the surrounding communities of Marietta, Columbia, and Wrightsville.

The dirt trail is a half-mile each way, so out and back is a mile-long journey.
