## Squires Lake Trail

*Washington*



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The Squires Lake Trail offers a short, but scenic, route along a former railroad grade about 13 miles south of Bellingham, the largest city in Whatcom County. The surface is dirt and gravel, but the trail is well maintained and well marked. And, although it's just a few minutes from Interstate 5, the dense tree cover offers a quiet peacefulness that one might not expect from such close proximity to a major roadway.

The hike involves a few short switchbacks, but trail users will be rewarded with a beautiful view of the lake at the end of the journey, and benches along the trail offer places to rest. To further explore the area, trail users can continue on the Squires Lake Loop for just shy of a mile. Other trails through the park also offer outstanding vistas, but are more challenging.
