Public parking lots can be found along NW 1st Street, north of Van Buren Avenue, and along SW 1st Street, north of SW Madison Avenue.



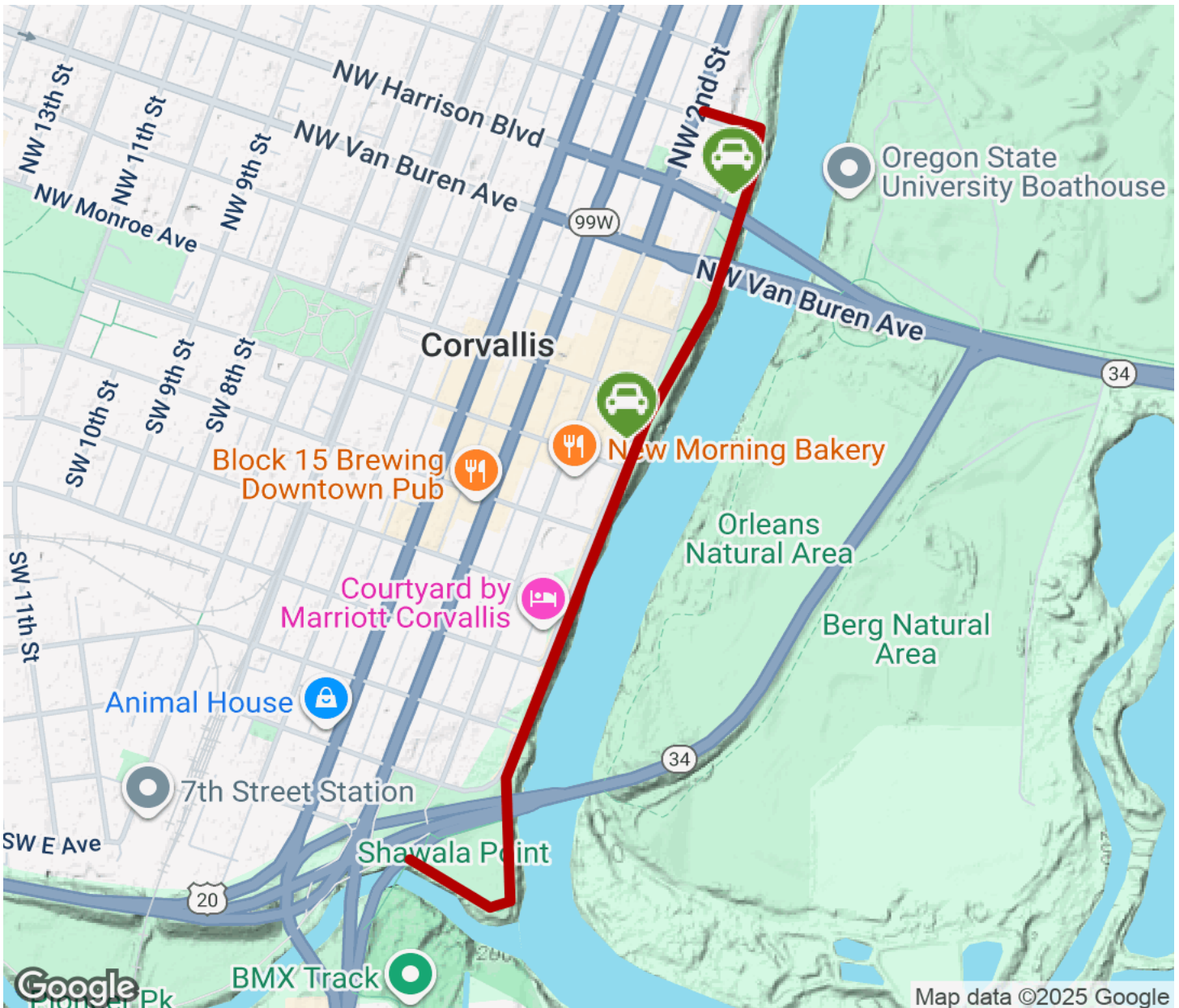
