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About the Route

The route gradually inclines traveling inland and parallels State Route 56 closely for much of the way. There's a short on-road segment on low-stress Azuaga Street near Interstate 15 at the northeast end of the trail.

Connections

On the western end, just west of I-5, is the <u>Sorrento Valley</u> <u>Road Trail</u>; unfortunately, there is no linking path for now, although long-term plans call for the connection to



be made.

The State Route 56 Bike Path runs between a dead end in Carmel Valley (San Diego) and Sabre Springs Pkwy (San Diego).


