### About the Route

The route gradually inclines traveling inland and parallels State Route 56 closely for much of the way. There's a short on-road segment on low-stress Azuaga Street near Interstate 15 at the northeast end of the trail.

### Connections

On the western end, just west of I-5, is the [Sorrento Valley Road Trail](#); unfortunately, there is no linking path for now, although long-term plans call for the connection to


