Corson's Inlet Rail-Trail begins at the parking lot off County 619 (by the bridge) in Corson's Inlet State Park and runs for a short



Corson's Inlet Rail-Trail begins at the parking lot off County 619 (by the bridge) in Corson's Inlet State Park and runs for a short distance across the upper dunes above the beach. There are plans to extend the trail a short distance farther to 59th Street, for access to the state park from town.

The dunes and beach provide an important—and fragile—habitat for nesting shore birds. Please mind beach closures during the nesting season. A fee is required to use the park and for fishing and boat launching.

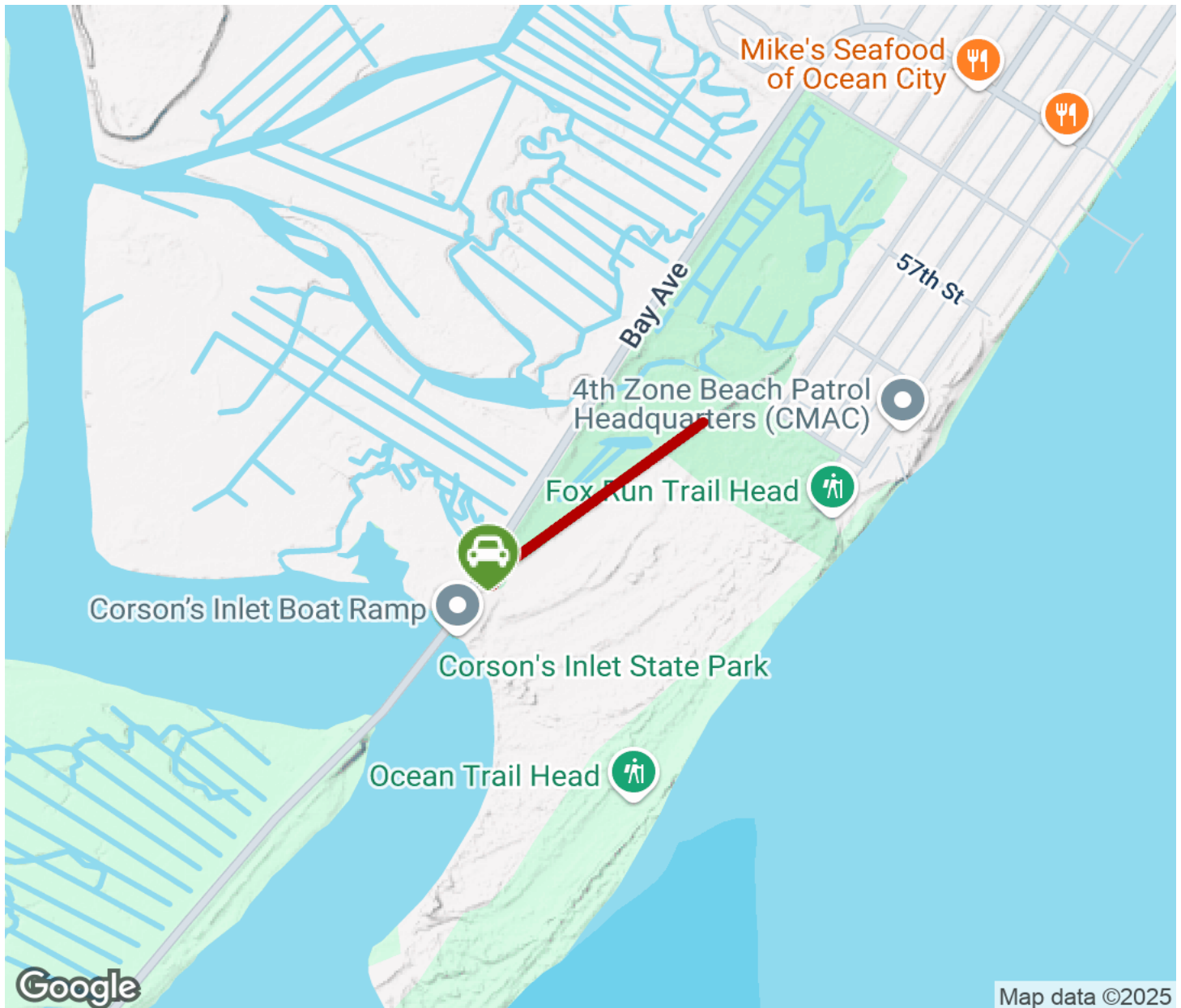
