The King Avenue East Trail, in southwestern Billings, provides a half-mile concrete route along the south side of the roadway with access to a busy commercial subdivision at its eastern end. It's hoped that one day the trail will continue east to provide a valuable link to Ponderosa Elementary School.

From its western end, you can head north along the [South Billings Boulevard Trail](#), or cross King Avenue and travel west along the sidewalk to reach Amend Park, which offers a recreational facility, soccer fields and picnic sites.

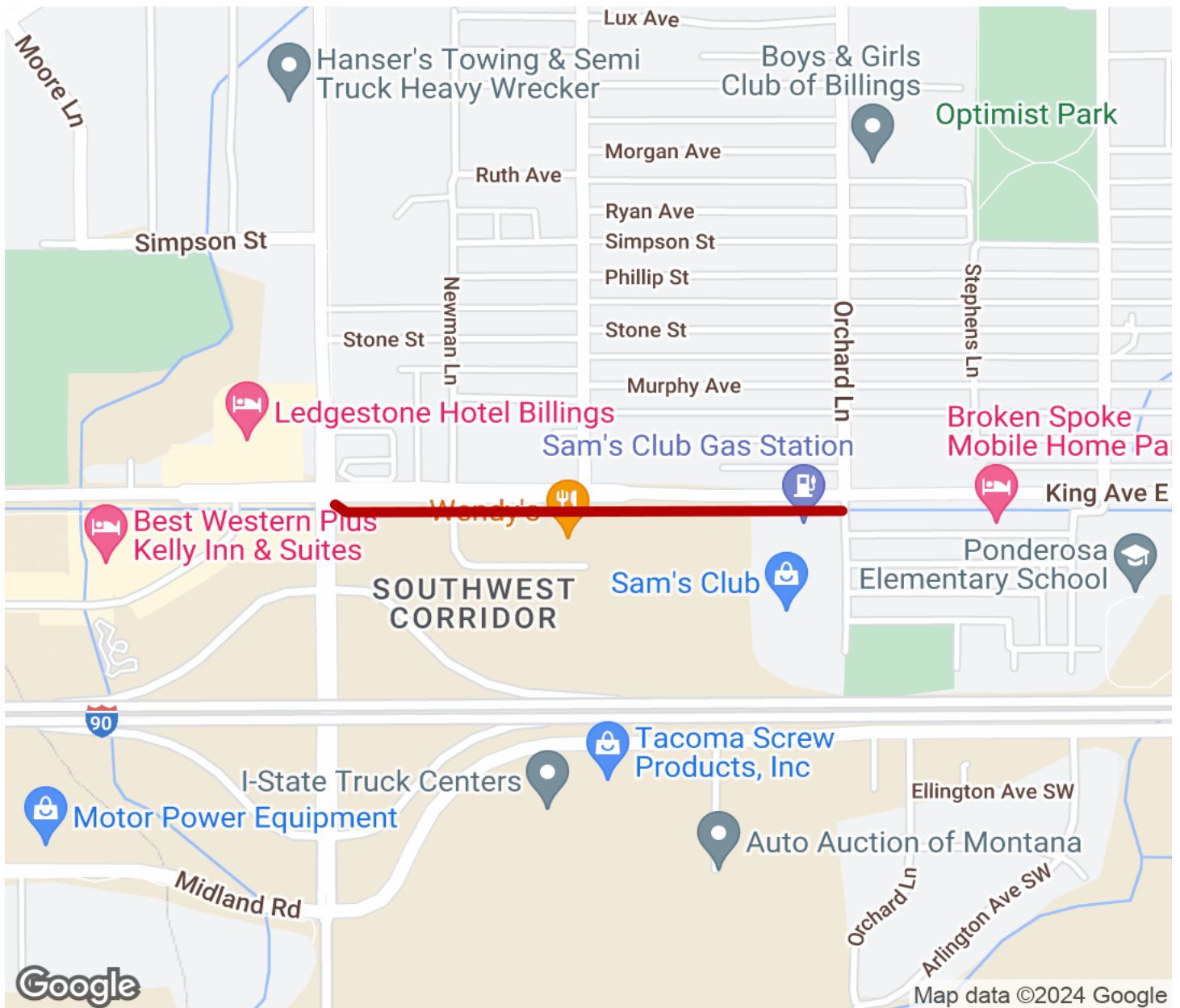
Parking & Trail Access
