The Skyline Trail offers beautiful views of Billings and the Yellowstone Valley on a paved 7-mile route through the northern



Head west and you'll travel along the sandstone formation known as Rimrocks (or The Rims) and then parallel the south side of Billings Logan International Airport.

The Skyline Trail offers beautiful views of Billings and the Yellowstone Valley on a paved 7-mile route through the northern end of town. Springtime is especially pleasant with wildflowers blooming along the trail. Trailside benches and picnic tables provide places to rest and enjoy the scenery.

A highlight of your trip will be Swords Park, offering a scenic natural setting crisscrossed with walking paths and historic sites such as Boothill Cemetery, dating back to the late 1800s.

From the eastern end of the trail, you can also connect to the 2-mile [Alkali Creek Trail](#), or the shorter [Aronson Avenue Trail](#).

Parking & Trail Access

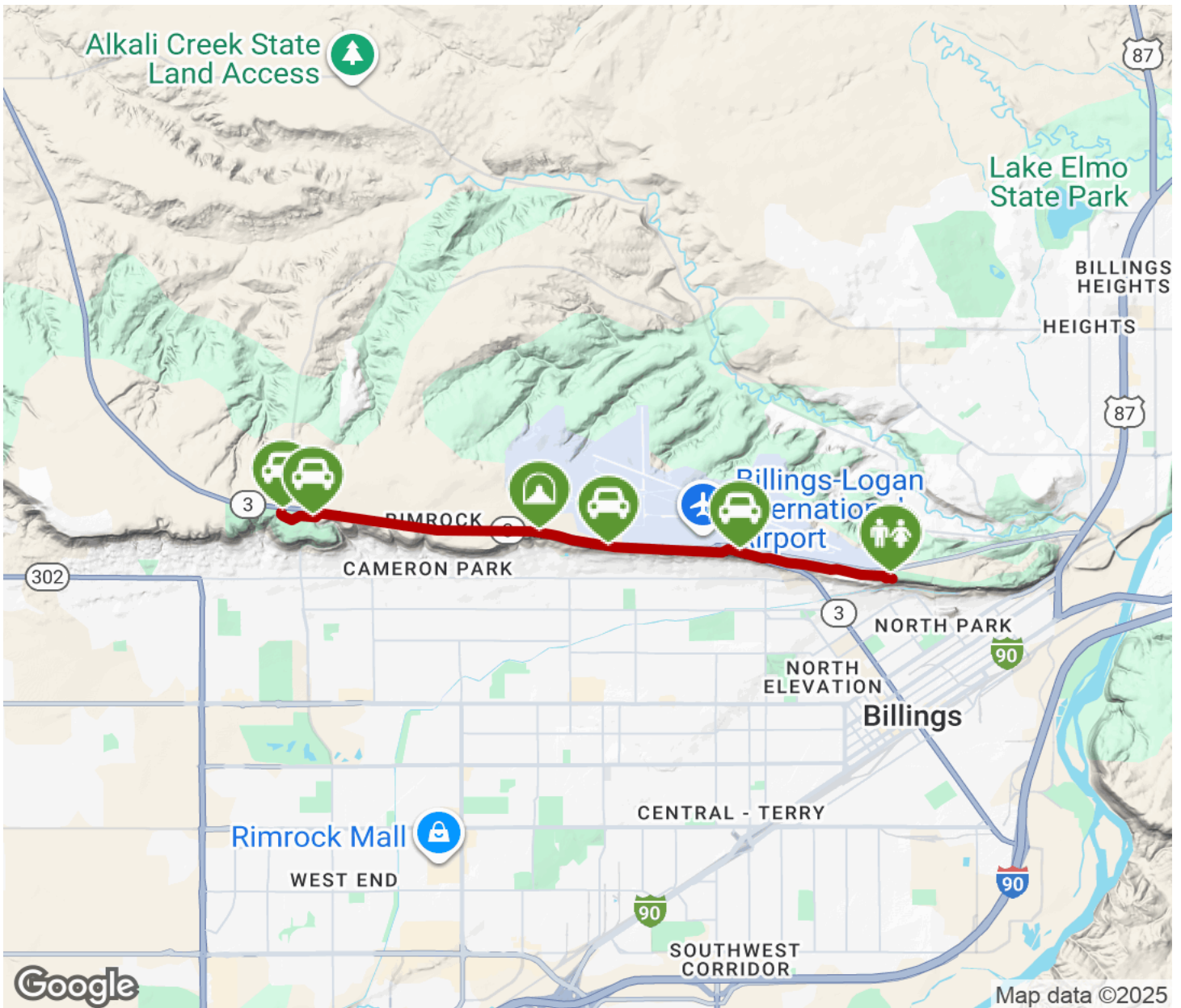
The Skyline Trail runs between Zimmerman Park, 3314 MT-3 (Billings), and Swords Park (Billings), with parking available at both ends.
