The Zimmerman Trail is a north-south route in western Billings that parallels the eastern flank of a roadway of the same name. The paved pathway is just over a mile long with pleasant neighborhood views.

From the trail's southern end, travel east along the north side of Broadwater Avenue to reach Lillis Park and the northern trailhead for the <u>BBWA Canal Trail</u>.
