From the trail's southern end, travel east along the north side of Broadwater Avenue to reach Lillis Park and the northern trailhead for the [BBWA Canal Trail](#).

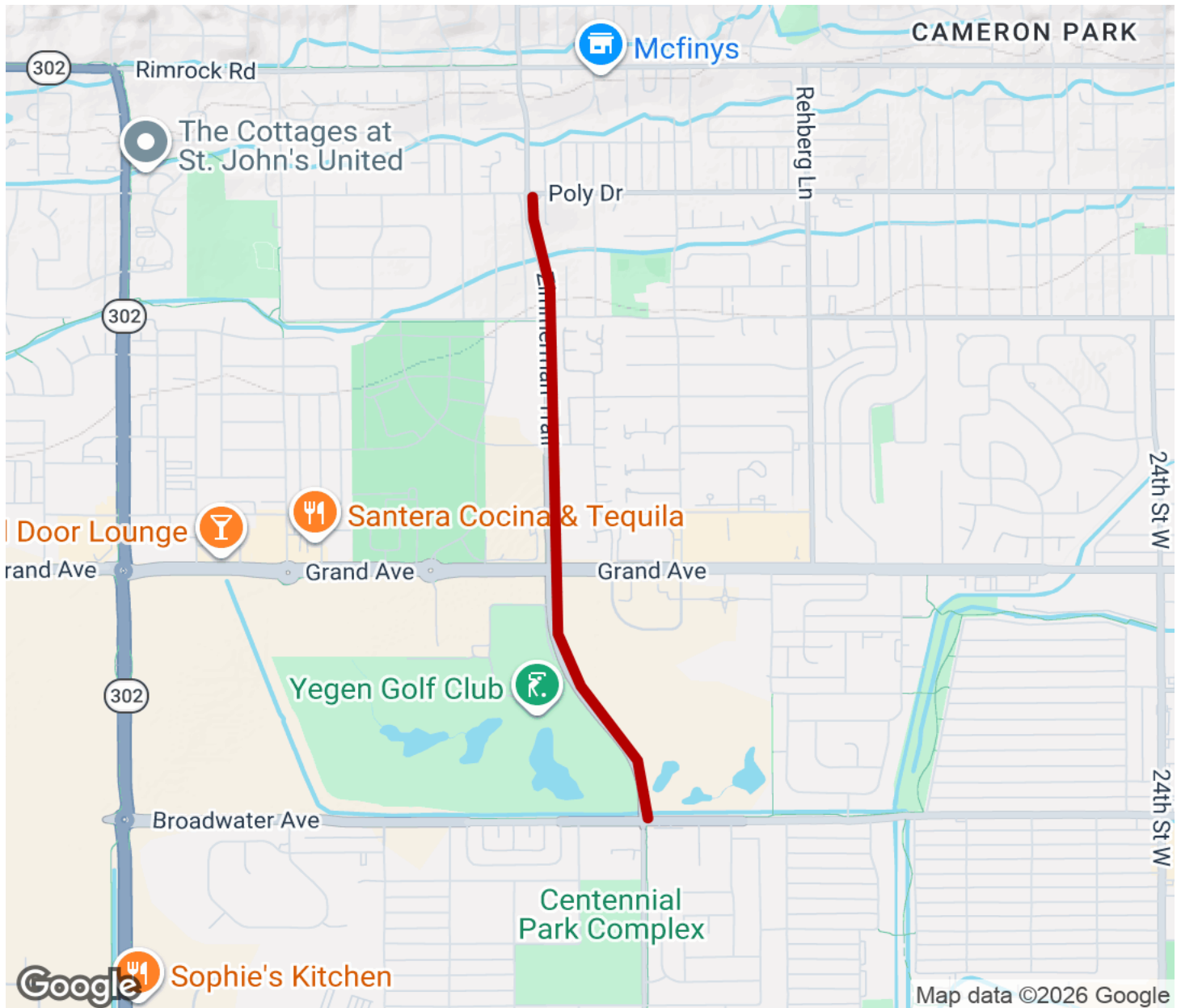
