Chain of Lakes Trail

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The Chain of Lakes Trail stretches nearly 5 miles along an abandoned rail corridor between downtown Winter Haven and



The Chain of Lakes Trail stretches nearly 5 miles along an abandoned rail corridor between downtown Winter Haven and north of Lake Alfred in central Florida.

About the Route

As its name implies, the Chain of Lakes Trail passes numerous lakes along the way, as well as parks, neighborhoods, and businesses. The trail leaves off from Lake Alfred and heads south along a bike/pedestrian bridge over US 17/92. The trail heads directly south into downtown Winter Haven and crosses over the busy Avenue T using another Bike/pedestrian bridge.

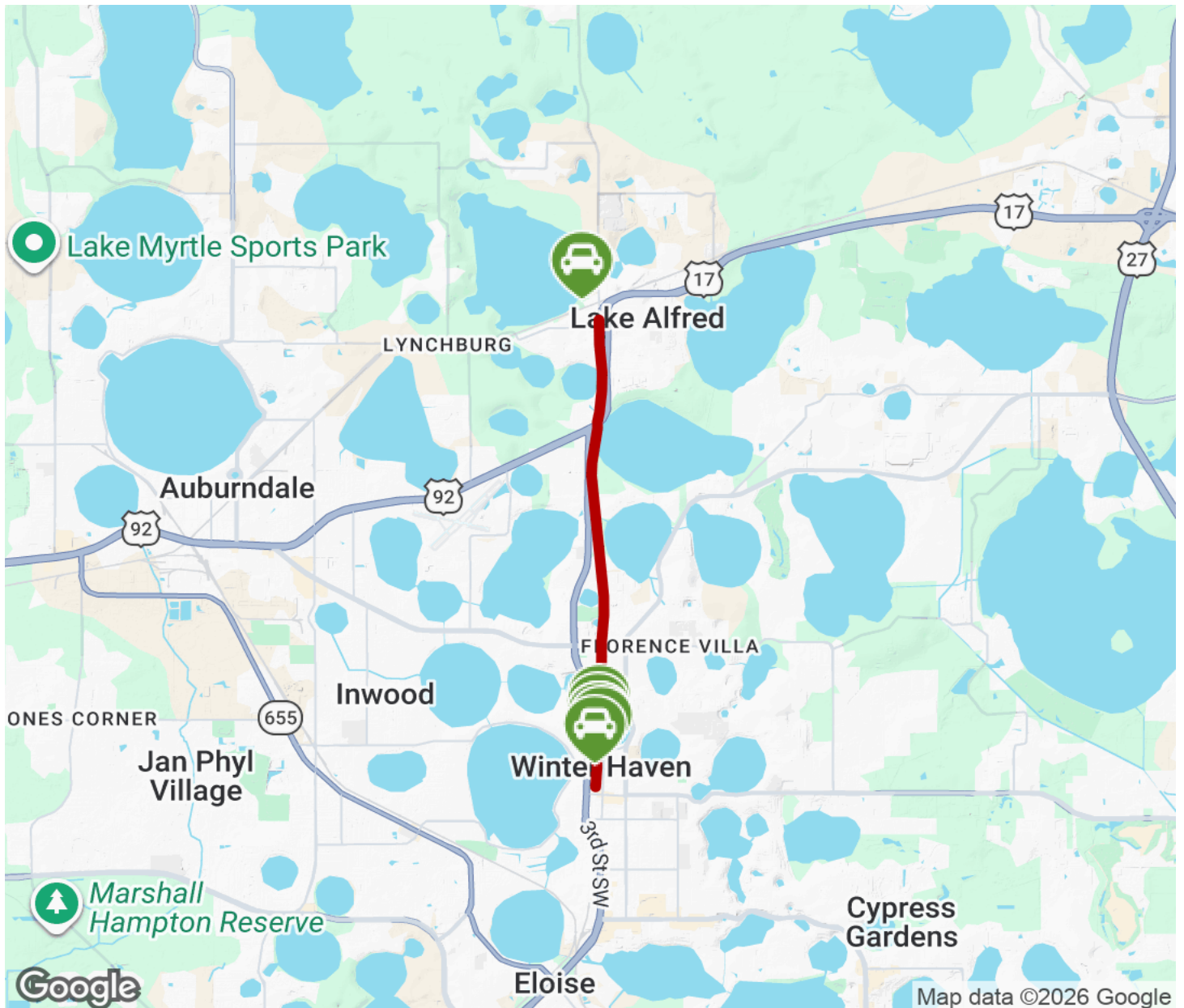
