

Blue Marsh Lake Trail Pennsylvania



The Blue Marsh Lake Multi-Use Trail loops for 29.4 miles around a manmade reservoir just outside of Reading in southeastern



and boat launches; restrooms can be found at the lake's visitor center.

Connections

At the eastern end of the trail, the Blue Marsh Lake Trail connects to the <u>Union Canal Trail</u>.

The Blue Marsh Lake Multi-Use Trail loops for 29.4 miles around a manmade reservoir just outside of Reading in southeastern Pennsylvania. The trail has a mixture of surfaces (hard-packed dirt, grass, gravel, and abandoned roads) with some single-tracking and climbs that make it best suited for hiking, mountain biking, and horseback riding.

About the Route

The trail travels through open fields and woodlands and enjoys spectacular views of the lake. Bird watching is popular on the trail, especially during the fall's hawk migration. As a recreational hotspot, trail users will also find many amenities, including picnic areas, food concession stands, a small beach (swimming allowed),
