Goose Creek Greenway

Colorado

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The Goose Creek Greenway offers a major east-west route through Boulder. Note that there is little shade along the way and the pathway runs through busy commercial areas, including the Villa Shopping Center.

On the trail's western end, you can access East Mapleton Park and Ball Fields, as well as [Elmer's Two Mile Creek Greenway](#). At its eastern end, the trail forks; go north to explore Valmont Bike Park, or head south to hop on the [Boulder Creek Path](#), which can take you downtown and to the University of Colorado.

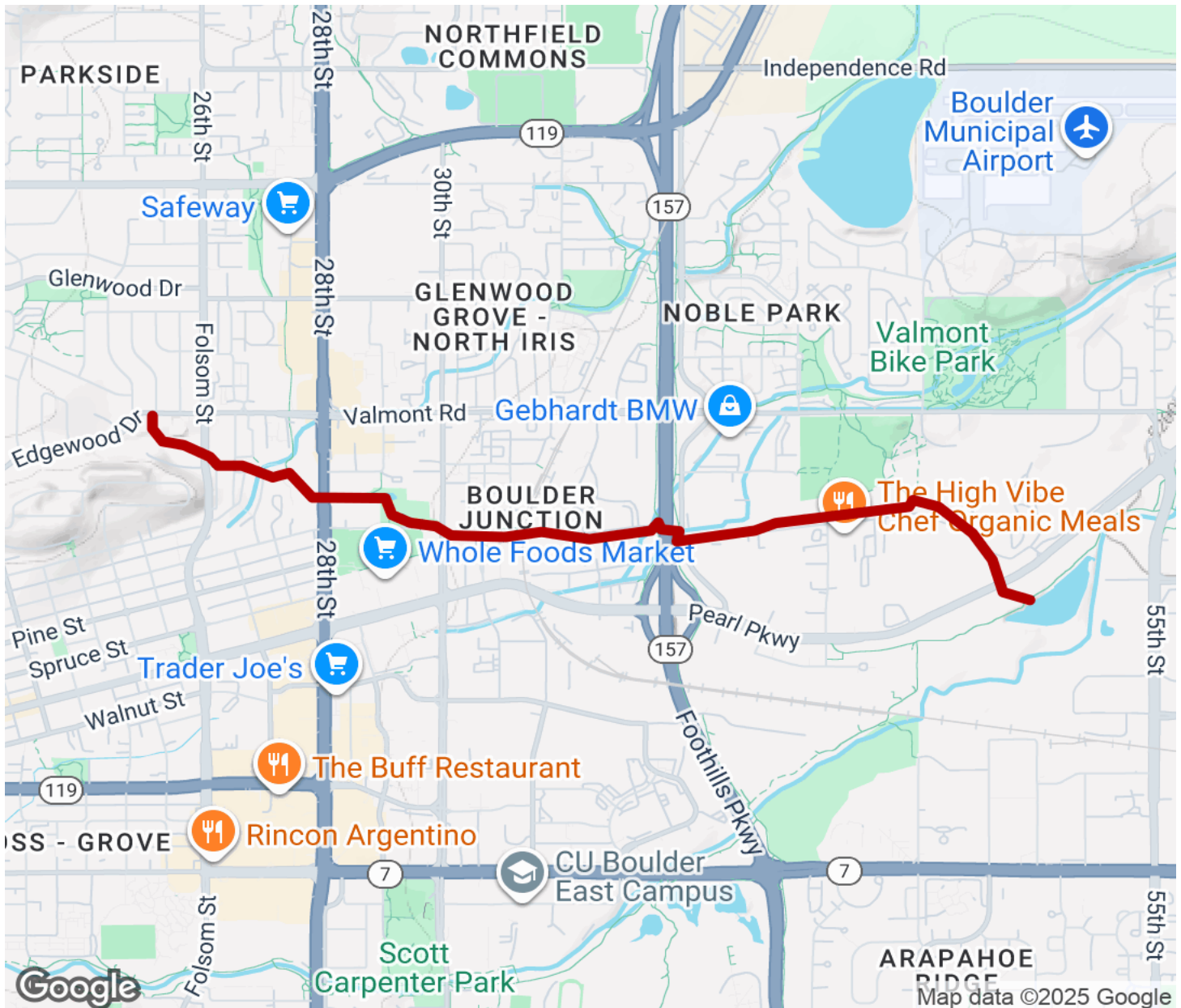
Parking & Trail Access
