The half-mile 8th Street Greenway begins at North Loop Road and follows a tree-lined northwesterly route to Bakers Creek Park,



The half-mile 8th Street Greenway begins at North Loop Road and follows a tree-lined northwesterly route to Bakers Creek Park, where it connects to [a trail](#) of the same name which is part of a regional network called the Carolina Thread Trail.

The greenway is paved, wide and flat through a peaceful area, making for an easy and pleasant trip. The park provides trail goers with restrooms, picnic areas, basketball and tennis courts, a playground and a miniature golf course.

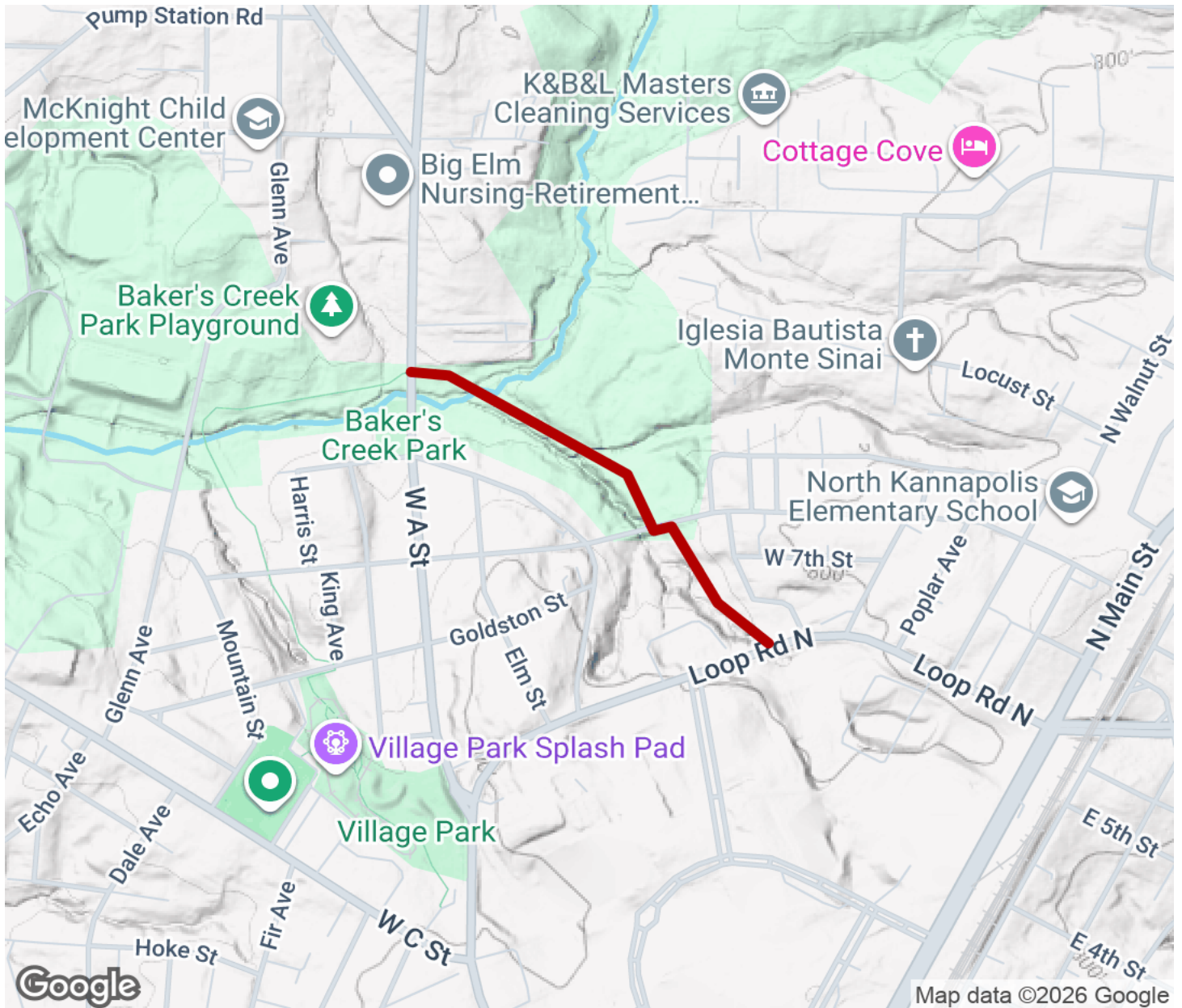
Parking & Trail Access
