The rail-withtrail skirts the edge of the new housing developments centered on Newbury Way and Lochdale Terrace. Because the active railroad is perched on a hill above the path, trail users can occasionally catch glimpses of Norfolk Southern freight trains through the trees.

Parking & Trail Access


Parking for the South Elkhorn Trail can be found along neighborhood streets in southern Lexington.
