The South Elkhorn Trail is a short community path in the southern reaches of Lexington, Kentucky. The rail-with-trail skirts the edge of the new housing developments centered on Newbury Way and Lochdale Terrace. Because the active railroad is perched on a hill above the path, trail users can occasionally catch glimpses of Norfolk Southern freight trains through the trees.

Parking for the South Elkhorn Trail can be found along neighborhood streets in southern Lexington.



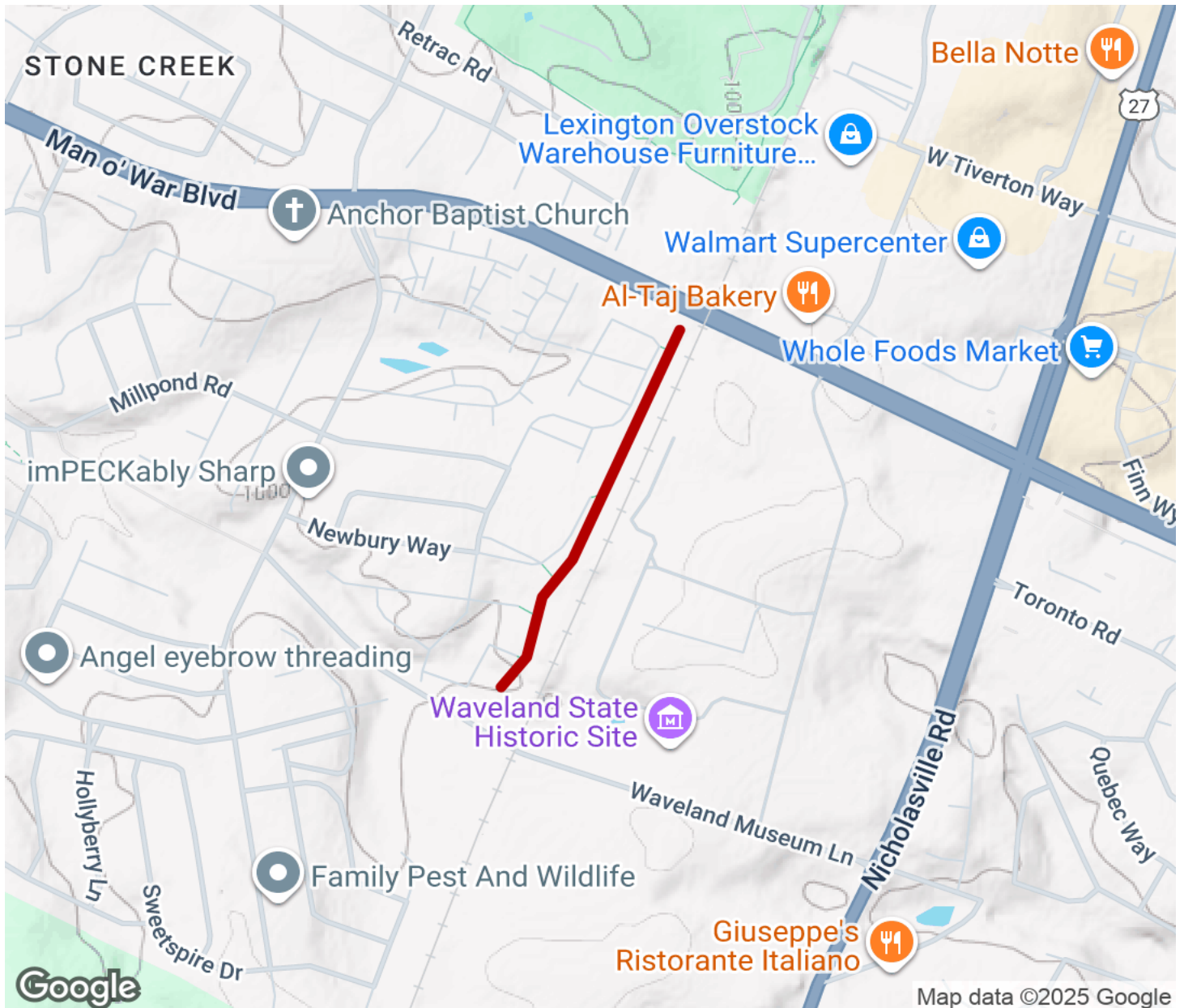
