On the eastern end, a parking lot is available at the Marina Road Trailhead.



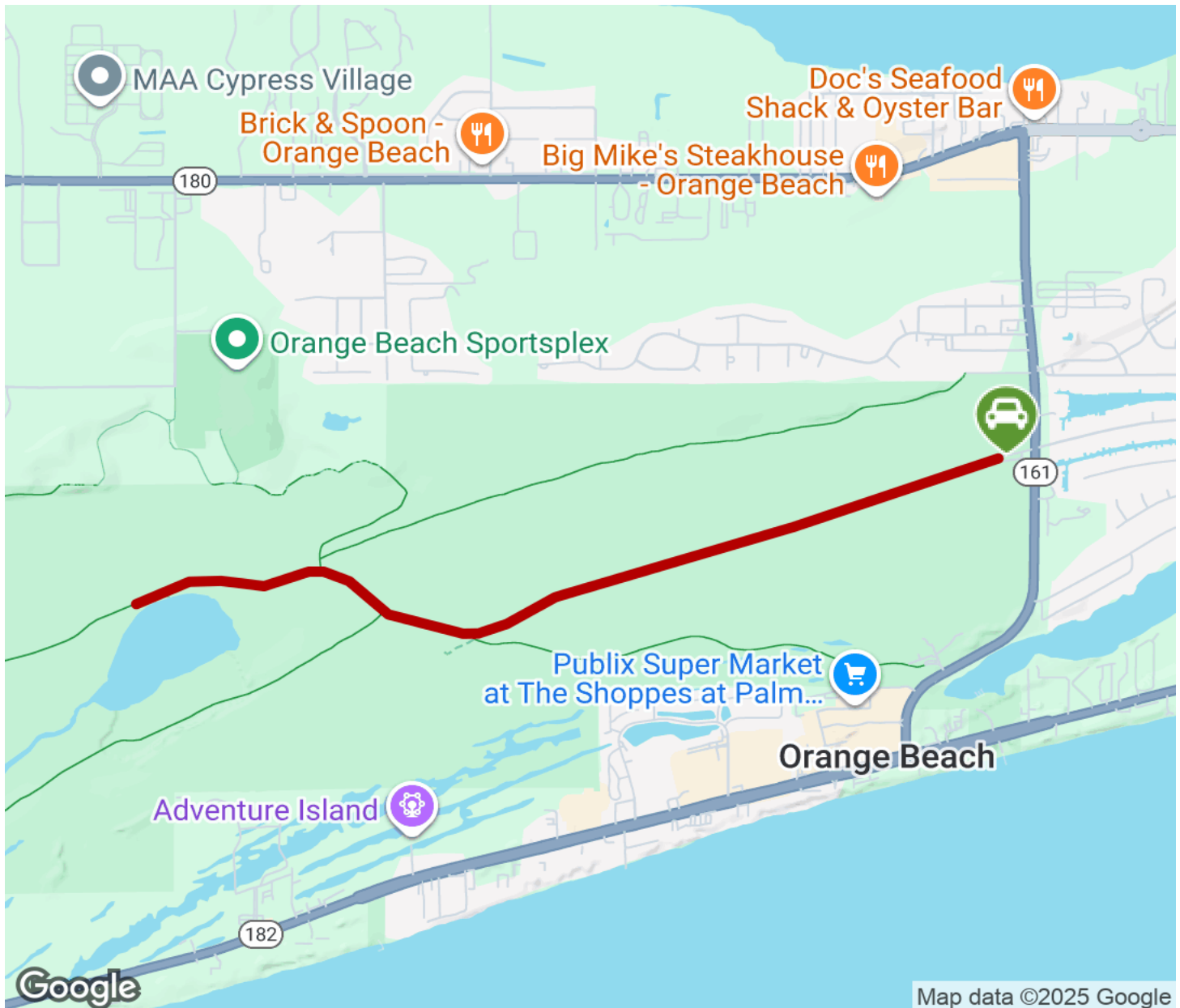
