The Twin Bridges Trail is only a mile long, but offers a tranquil journey through part of Gulf State Park in southern Alabama. At its northern end, it connects to the 3-mile <u>Gulf Oak Ridge Trail</u> and, at its southern end, joins the <u>Rattlesnake Ridge Trail</u> and <u>Catman Road Trail</u>. The paved route makes its way through dense forests abundant with wildlife and travels over scenic wooden bridges.
