Duck Creek Trail (WI)

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On the western end, the Duck Creek Trail picks up where the [Newton Blackmour State Trail](#) leaves off, that is just east of the town of Seymour at Vanderheuvell Road. Traveling along an old railroad route, the trail passes through a wooded corridor among farms, paralleling State Route 54, ending shortly after the highway crosses County Road U.

In Seymour, street parking is available.



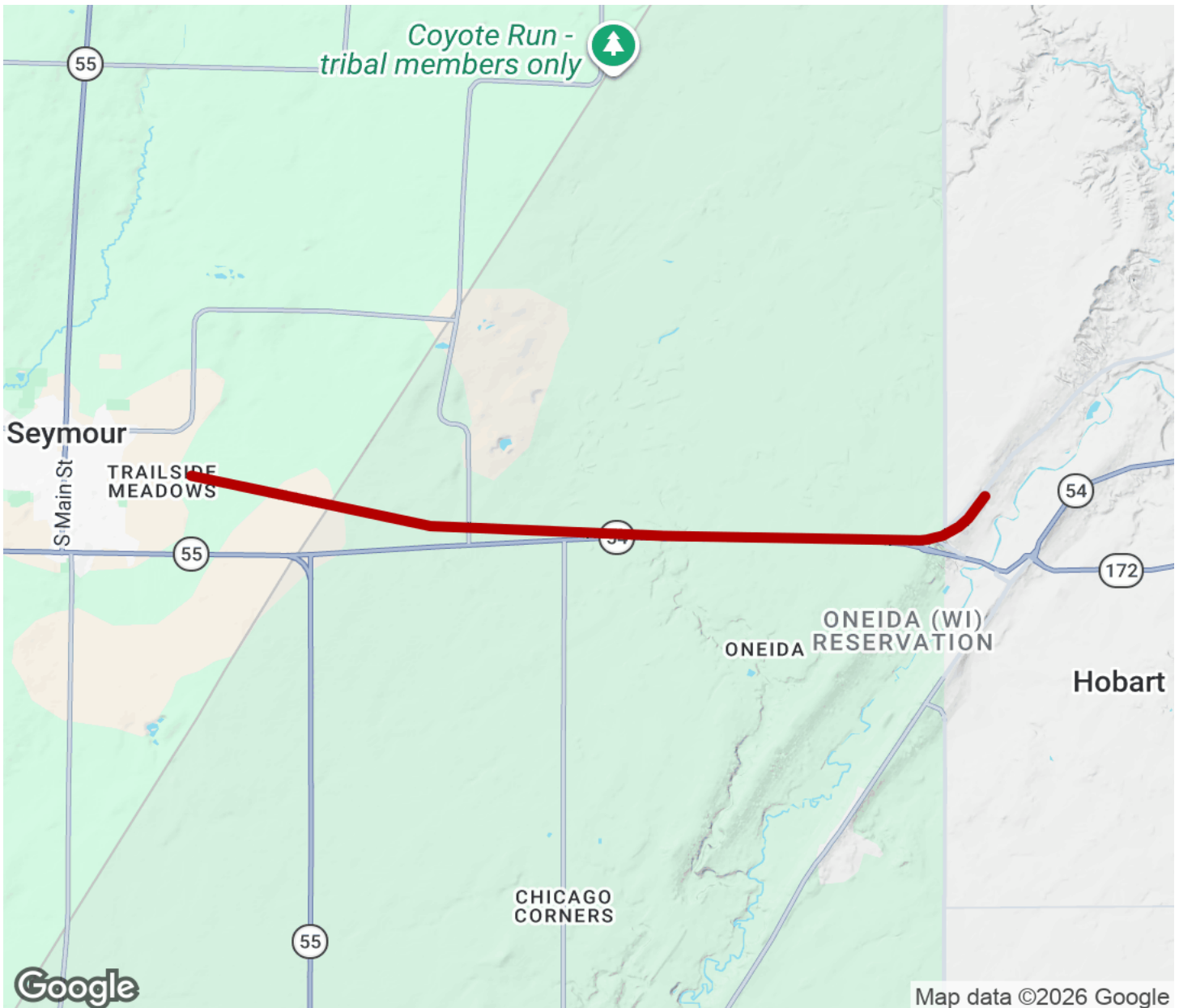
