As its name implies, the Seaside Promenade is a north-south route along the Pacific Ocean in the Oregon coastal community of Seaside. The Prom, as it's affectionately known, dates back to the 1920s and offers a smooth, flat trail with spectacular beach views on one side and resorts and oceanfront homes on the other. On its northern end, you'll find the popular Seaside Aquarium, which features regional marine life and a whale skeleton. A little further south, the promenade arrives at Turnaround Point (at the end of Broadway Street), where sits a statue of Lewis and Clark. And, all along the way, the trail is never far from shops and restaurants.

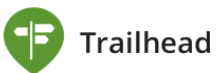
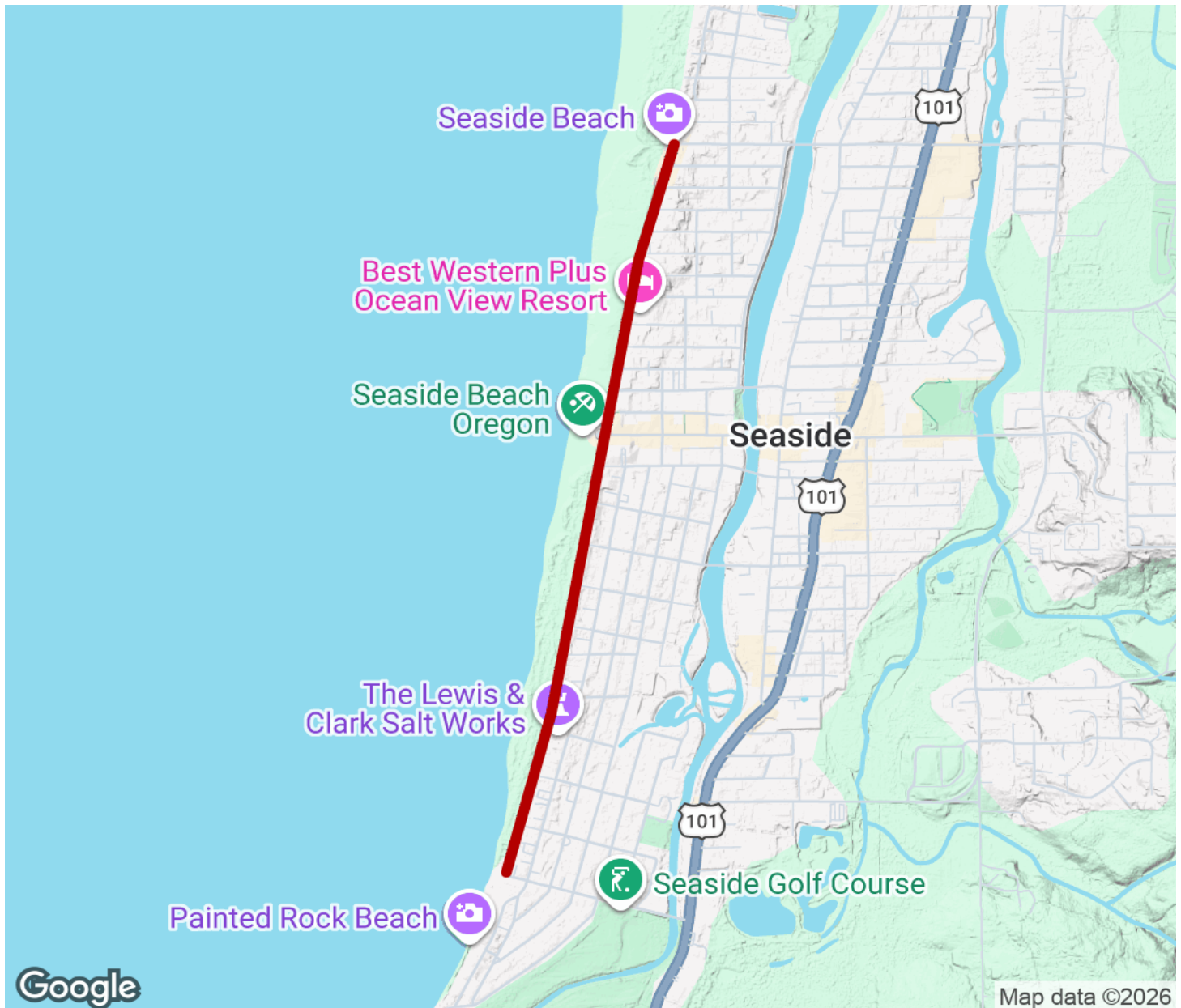
