Randall Road Bike Trail

Illinois



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The Randall Road Bike Trail offers a 4-mile paved north-south route along its namesake roadway in a suburb west of Chicago. A highlight of the journey is the trail's passage through the LeRoy Oakes Forest Preserve, offering beautiful prairie and woodland habitats. It's here (on the south side of Dean Street) that you can connect to the [Great Western Trail](#), which stretches 17 miles northwest to Sycamore.

From the Randall Road Bike Trail's northern end at Silver Glen Road, you can also connect to the [River Bend Trail](#) (also known as the Silver Glen Trail) to go west to the Silver Glen Crossings shopping center, or east to reach the scenic 37-mile [Fox River Trail](#).

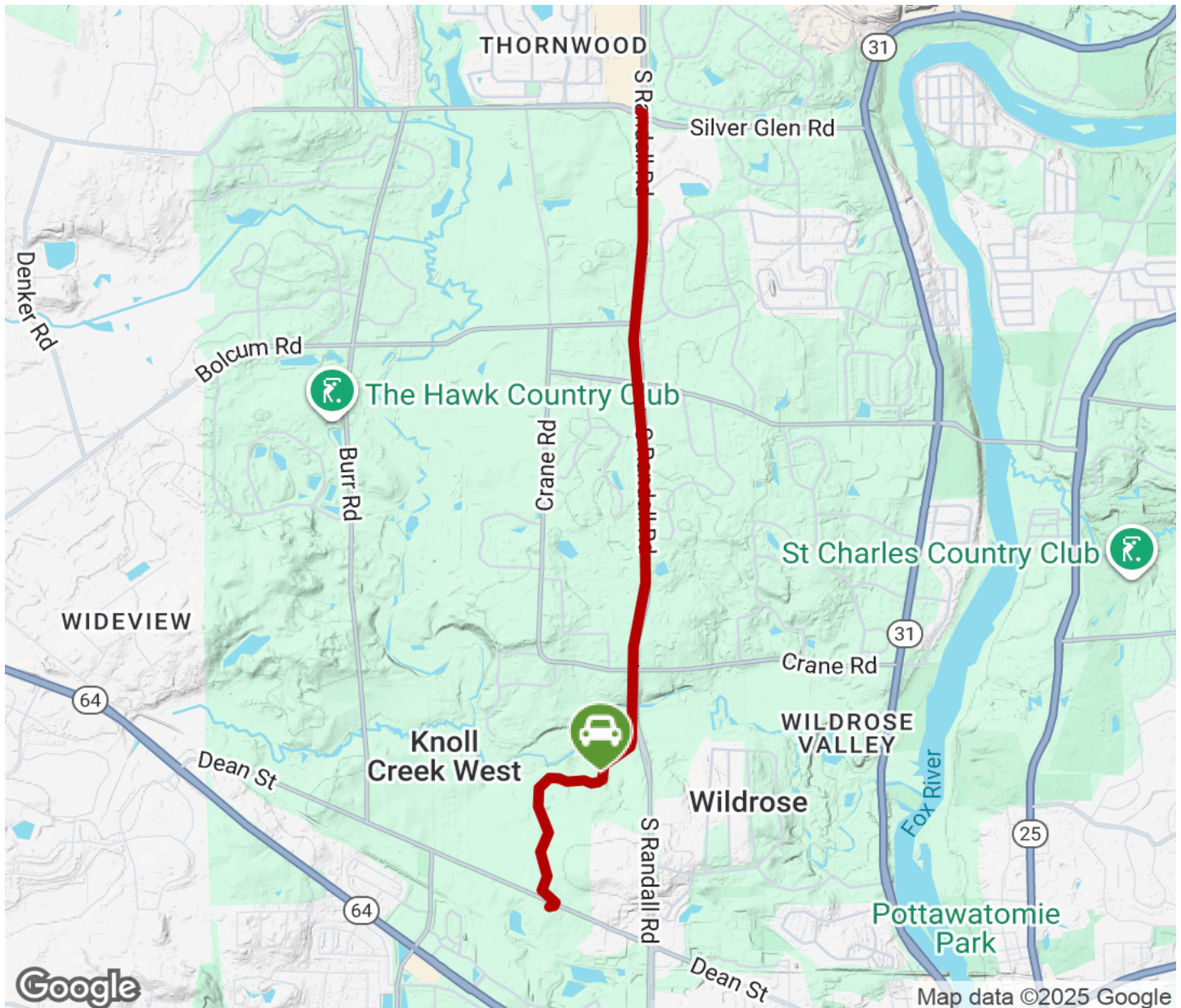
