The park offers a playground and wide grassy areas perfect for a picnic or game of frisbee. From there, the trail continues south and, after an underpass at Valmont Road, reaches the [Goose Creek Greenway](#), an east-west route across the city.

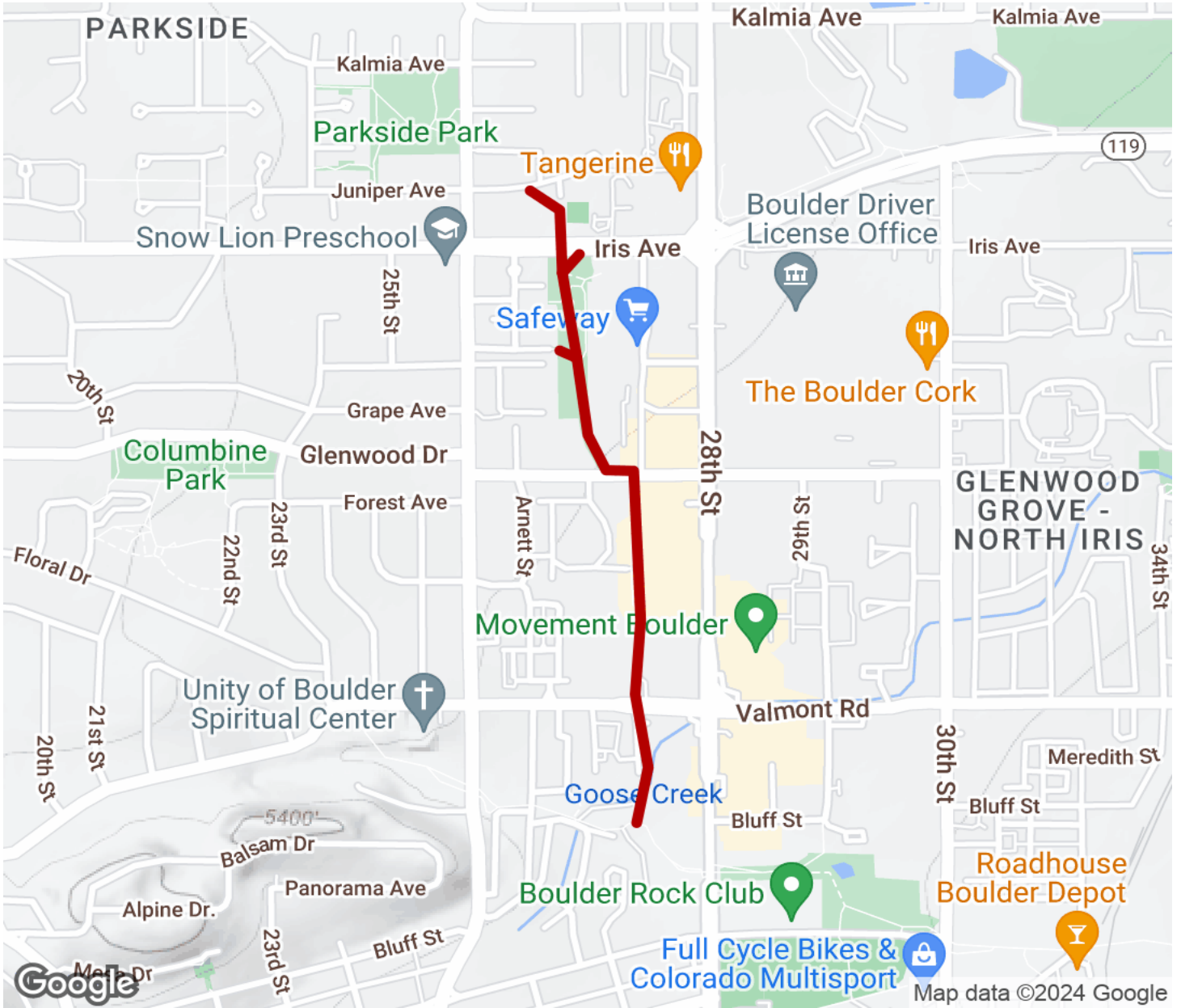
## Parking & Trail Access
