Along the way, you'll enjoy spectacular mountain scenery and views of Dillon Reservoir. Various spurs provide access to the resort's core, including the Lakeside Village and Mountain House areas.

At the trail's western endpoint, trail users can pick up the [Swan Mountain Recpath](#) from the Summit Cove neighborhood to climb to the spectacular Sapphire Point Overlook.

Ample parking is available at a trailhead on US 6, directly opposite Cemetery Road (roughly halfway between Dillon and Summit Cove).



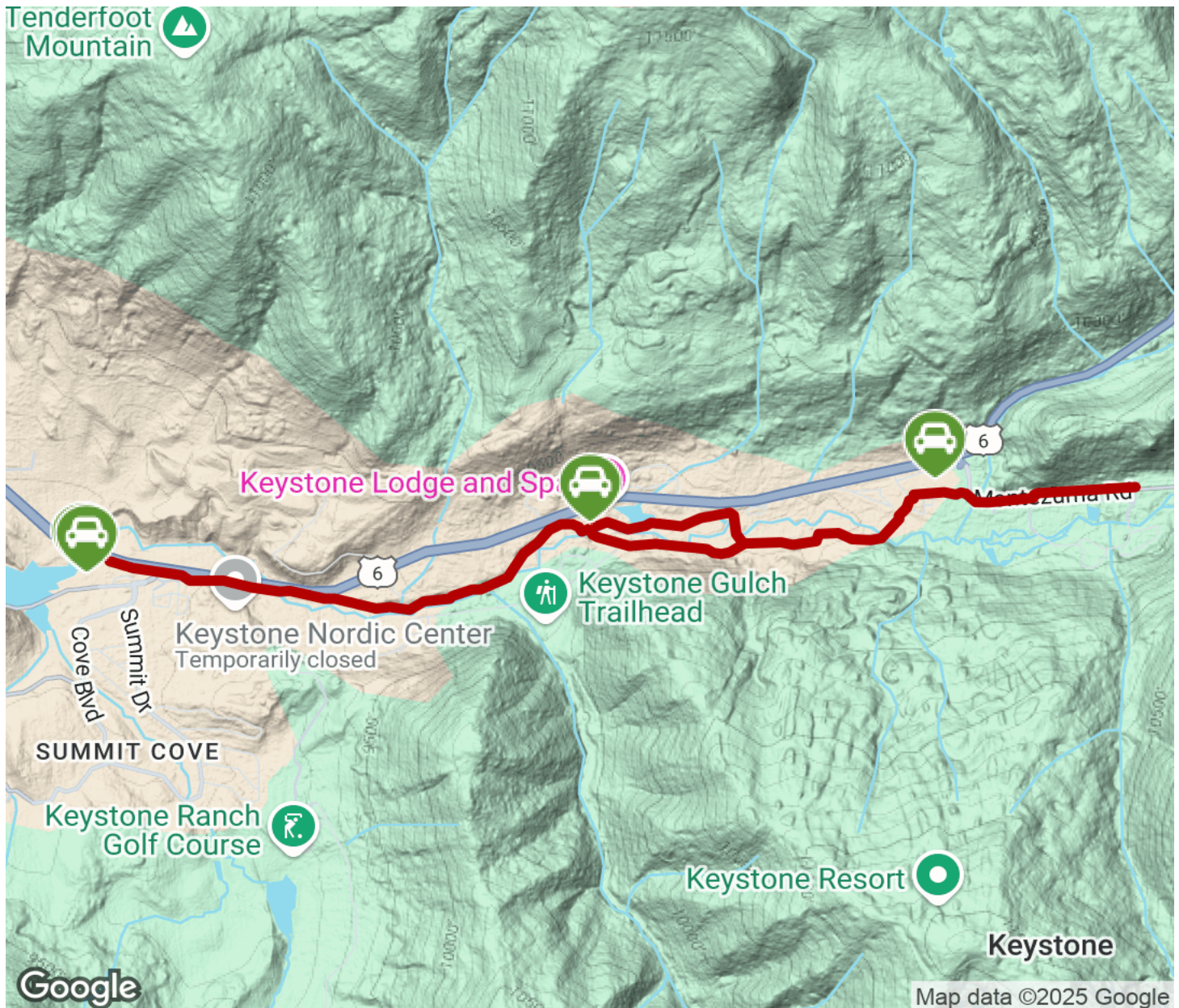
