From its southern end, you can access popular Sibley Park, where you can enjoy a variety of recreational opportunities, including softball, tennis, fishing, picnicking and even a farm.

The North Minnesota River Trail also provides important connections to two other trails: the 13-mile [Red Jacket Trail](#) near its southern end, and the 39-mile [Sakatah Singing Hills State Trail](#) at its northern end.

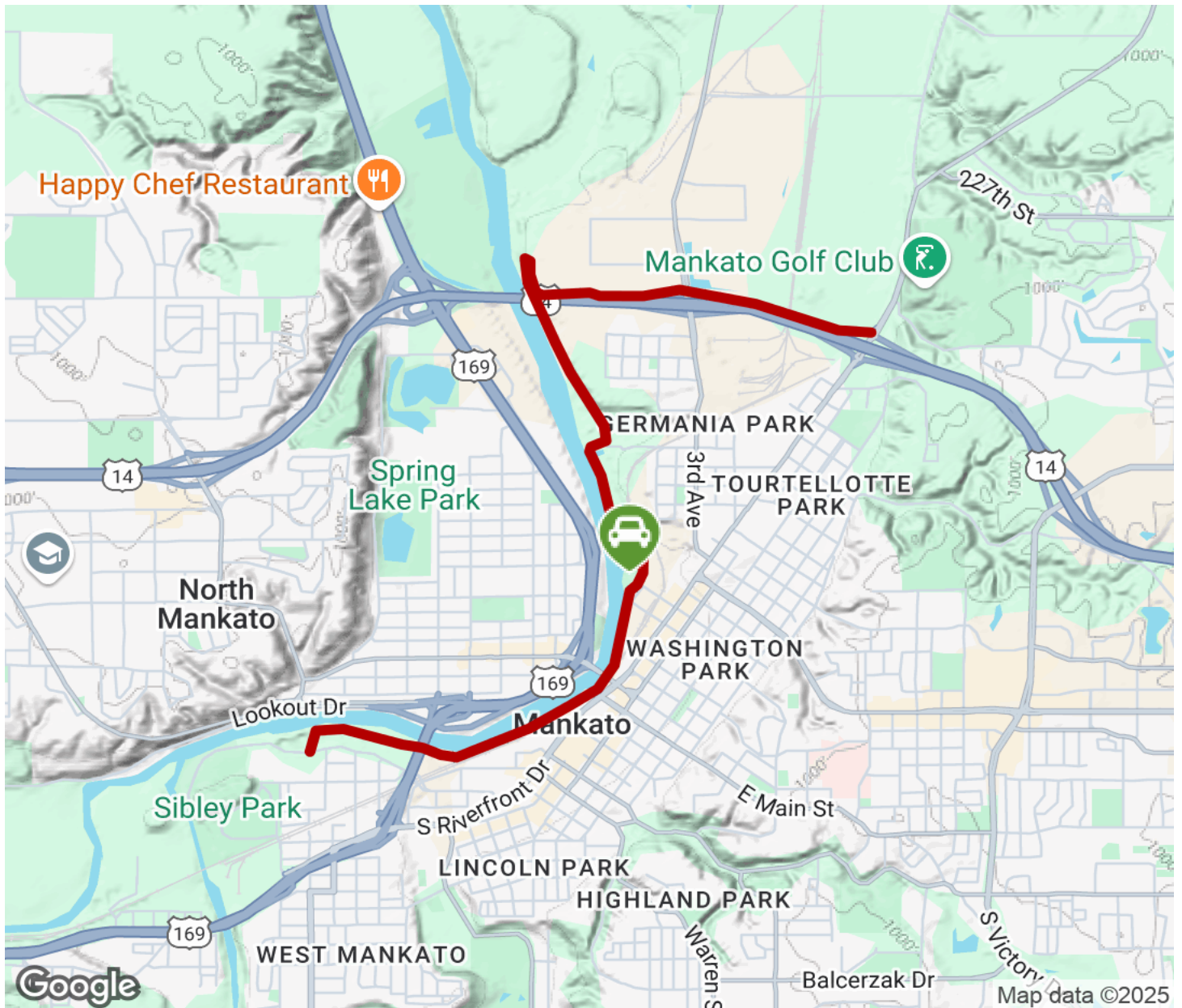
Parking & Trail Access
