From its southern end, you can access popular Sibley Park, where you can enjoy a variety of recreational opportunities, including softball, tennis, fishing, picnicking and even a farm.

The North Minnesota River Trail also provides important connections to two other trails: the 13-mile Red Jacket Trail near its southern end, and the 39-mile Sakatah Singing Hills State Trail at its northern end.

About mid-trail, is Riverfront Park, which offers parking lots off W. Elm Street and W. Rock Street. A spur off the trail's southern end leads to Sibley Park (900 Mound Avenue), where parking can also be found.
