The South Omaha Trail serves as an important connector for the city, linking the Keystone Trail, Karen Park, Karen Western



The South Omaha Trail serves as an important connector for the city, linking the [Keystone Trail](#), Karen Park, Karen Western Elementary School and the [Field Club Trail](#). The paved pathway is built on a former Chicago & North Western rail line and has a slight uphill grade when running from west to east.

An old train bridge that crosses S. 60th Street (just south of F Street) has been incorporated into the trail and a considerable amount of wildlife can also be seen from the pathway, including deer, woodchucks and many types of birds.

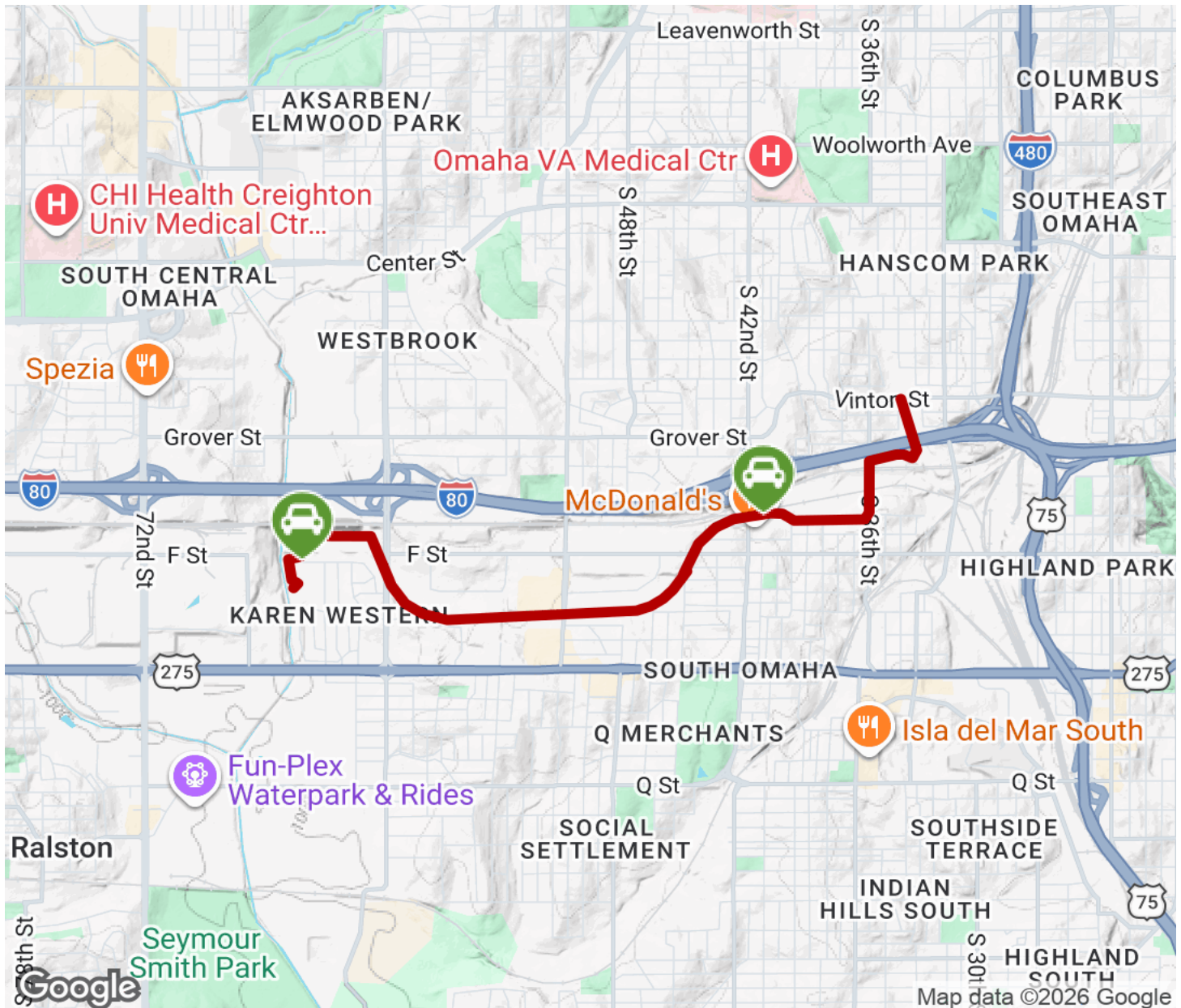
Parking & Trail Access
